### 2022 PGA TOUR Hawai'i Events | Pre-Travel Testing Requirements

In preparation for the upcoming events in Hawai'i (Sentry Tournament of Champions and SONY Open), please be aware of specific testing and travel requirements for the state of Hawai'i.

As you are aware, individual states and local authorities may have specific requirements and protocols that we must follow when we are conducting our events. Outlined below are the requirements for our events being held in Hawai'i.

Note: Each step must be followed before boarding a flight to Hawai'i.

- 1. **SAFE TRAVELS HAWAII REGISTRATION:** Prior to departing for Hawai'i, all travelers must complete the State of Hawai'i's Safe Travels program application form. Follow the steps below to ensure a seamless arrival process.
  - a. Create an account or log in to your account from 2021 at: <a href="https://travel.hawaii.gov">https://travel.hawaii.gov</a>. You will input your personal information, arrival, and departure details.
  - b. When prompted, upload your vaccination card and/or your negative COVID test results.
  - c. Within **24 hours** of your departure, please log-in to your account and answer the health questionnaire. Once completed, you will be e-mailed a QR code. You may take a screen shot, print, or log back into the Hawaii Safe Travels site to retrieve.
  - d. Show the QR code at your last departure city to get your Pre-Clear wristband. Your Pre-Clear wristband will allow entry to Hawaii as normal. If your specific airline does not provide a Pre-Clear wristband, have your QR code readily available for entry.
    - i. If your departure information changes after filling out this link, you will not need to update.

#### 2. **PRE-TRAVEL TESTING:**

- a. U.S. Citizens, U.S. Nationals, Permanent Residents, and Immigrants
  - i. **FULLY VACCINATED:** Travelers will need to upload a copy of their vaccination card to the Hawai'i Safe Travels site prior to arrival, <a href="https://travel.hawaii.gov">https://travel.hawaii.gov</a>
    - Please Note: If you are a U.S. citizen, fully vaccinated and traveling from an international destination directly to Hawaii; you are required to present a negative COVID test taken within <u>one day</u> of boarding flight to U.S. (subject to change)
      - Acceptable type of test: antigen or nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT)
    - 2. As an extra precaution, please have your vaccine card with you upon arrival
  - ii. NOT FULLY VACCINATED: Travelers will be required to provide proof of a negative COVID test from a Trusted Testing and Travel Partner, <a href="https://hawaiicovid19.com/travel-partners/">https://hawaiicovid19.com/travel-partners/</a>, no more than 72 hours BEFORE boarding the final leg of their trip to Hawai'i
    - 1. Acceptable type of test: nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT)
      - a. Antigen will NOT be accepted
    - 2. **Please Note:** If you are a U.S. citizen, not fully vaccinated and traveling from an international destination directly to Hawaii; you are required to present a negative test within <u>one day</u> of boarding flight to U.S. (subject to change)

3. As an extra precaution, please have a hard copy of your negative test result with you upon arrival

#### b. Non-U.S. Citizens

- i. **FULLY VACCINATED:** Travelers will be required to provide BOTH a vaccination record AND a negative COVID test result no more than <u>one day</u> (subject to change) before your flight to the U.S. departs.
  - 1. Acceptable type of test: antigen or nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT).
  - 2. As an extra precaution, please have a hard copy of your negative test result and your vaccination card with you upon arrival
- ii. NOT FULLY VACCINATED: Unvaccinated foreign nationals will not be permitted into the United States

**IMPORTANT**: If you have tested positive for COVID in the last 90 days, please email <a href="mailto:healthandsafety@pgatourhq.com">healthandsafety@pgatourhq.com</a> as soon as possible and the team will provide necessary paperwork for entry into Hawaii.

**Reminder:** Everyone traveling domestically to Hawaii MUST complete the Safe Travels Hawai'i requirement by uploading your vaccination card or COVID test result as well as complete the State of Hawai'i Travel and Health Form within 24 hours of your departure, <a href="https://travel.hawaii.gov">https://travel.hawaii.gov</a>

To ensure a test result is received prior to travel the PGA TOUR suggests using Vault Health as your testing option for anyone that is unvaccinated:

#### VAULT HEALTH

Complimentary NAAT COVID-19 at-home test kits (nasal swab) can be ordered through Vault Health for players and caddies. The schedule below provides recommendations on when to order and administer a test, based on arrival date. Please email <a href="mailto:pgatour@vaulthealth.com">pgatour@vaulthealth.com</a> to order a test kit. Please order TWO tests in case of an error.

#### **NEW VAULT PROCESS:**

- o The at-home test kit (nasal swab) is now self-administered
- Specific instructions will be provided with the test kit
- Results will appear on the testing device within 30 minutes
- Once results are ready, take a photo of the device and email <u>pgatour@vaulthealth.com</u> along with the date, time, and your date of birth for a PDF of your results
- o The Hawaii travel results PDF will take up to 5 hours to generate

**IMPORTANT:** Vault tests no longer need to be shipped back.

- 3. **ON ISLAND TESTING:** For individuals that are not fully vaccinated, an antigen test will be **required** prior to arriving to the golf course at the beginning of the week. The TOUR will have testing provided within close proximity of the golf course

Further details pertaining to on island testing will be sent in the coming weeks. Prior to arrival, you will need to complete the travel link provided in the Player Advance Sheet only if you are <u>not fully</u> <u>vaccinated</u>.
