

In preparation for the upcoming event in Puerto Rico (Puerto Rico Open) please be aware of specific testing and travel requirements for Puerto Rico.

As you are aware, individual states and local authorities may have specific requirements and protocols that we must follow when we are conducting our events. Outlined below are the requirements for our events being held in Puerto Rico.

We will provide more information about on-island protocols in the Player Advance Sheet and on LINKS, however, outside of the entry requirements listed below into Puerto Rico, there will be no additional testing requirements to participate in the event or to access facilities, including Player Dining.

Note: Each step must be followed before boarding a flight to Puerto Rico.

1. **TRAVEL DECLARATION FORM:** Prior to departing for Puerto Rico, **ALL** travelers must complete the Travel Declaration Form on the Puerto Rico Health Department's online portal. Follow the steps below to ensure a seamless arrival process.
 - a. Create an account at: <https://1link.travelsafe.pr.gov/>. You will input your personal information, arrival and departure details.
 - b. When prompted, upload your vaccination card and/or your negative COVID test results.
 - c. A QR code will be emailed to you once you've completed the Travel Declaration Form. You may take a screen shot, print, or log back in to the Puerto Rico travel site to retrieve.
 - d. Show the QR code upon arrival in Puerto Rico.

2. **PRE-TRAVEL TESTING:**
 - a. **U.S. Citizens, U.S. Nationals, Permanent Residents, and Immigrants**
 - i. **FULLY VACCINATED:** Travelers will need to upload a copy of their vaccination card to the Travel Declaration site prior to arrival, <https://1link.travelsafe.pr.gov/>
 1. **As an extra precaution, please have your vaccine card with you upon arrival**
 2. Fully vaccinated is someone who has completed his/her series of vaccines, double or single and who has spent two weeks or more since their last does, either with a vaccine authorized by the FDA or by the WHO.
 - ii. **NOT FULLY VACCINATED:** Travelers will be required to show a negative COVID-19 test result (antigen or PCR), taken within 48 hours BEFORE arrival and upload the negative test result to the Travel Declaration site prior to arrival, <https://1link.travelsafe.pr.gov/>
 1. **Acceptable type of test:** Antigen or PCR performed by an authorized health provider (Unsupervised at-home tests will not be accepted)
 2. If you arrive in Puerto Rico without a test result, you must upload either a PCR molecular or antigen test performed by an authorized health provider taken on the Island within 48 hours of arrival or receive a fine. Travelers must quarantine during this period.
 3. **As an extra precaution, please have a hard copy of your negative test result with you upon arrival**

b. Non-U.S. Citizens

- i. **FULLY VACCINATED:** Travelers will be required to show BOTH a vaccination record AND a negative COVID test result taken within one day (subject to change) prior to departure.
 1. **Acceptable type of test:** antigen or PCR performed by an authorized health provider
 2. **As an extra precaution, please have a hard copy of your negative test result and your vaccination card with you upon arrival**

- ii. **NOT FULLY VACCINATED: Unvaccinated foreign nationals will not be permitted into the United States**

For those traveling with children, any domestic traveler above the age of 2 who is not vaccinated must get tested and present a negative antigen or PCR test performed by an authorized health provider. Children under the age of 2 are exempt.

- Any child traveling to Puerto Rico, their information can be completed in the same Travel Declaration Form as the parents

IMPORTANT: If you have tested positive for COVID in the last 90 days, please email healthandsafety@pgatourhq.com as soon as possible and the team will provide necessary paperwork for entry into Puerto Rico.

- If you have already received an exemption letter from the TOUR, you will need to complete a Travel Declaration Form and upload the exemption letter and copy of your positive result to receive a QR code prior to arrival in Puerto Rico.

Reminder: Everyone traveling to Puerto Rico MUST complete the Travel Declaration Form by uploading your vaccination card or COVID test result <https://1link.travelsafe.pr.gov/>

For anyone that is unvaccinated and requires a test to enter Puerto Rico, and to ensure a test result is received prior to travel, the PGA TOUR suggests using Vault Health as your testing option.

- **VAULT HEALTH**
Complimentary Lucira (NAAT) COVID-19 at-home test kits (nasal swab) can be ordered through Vault Health for players and caddies. The schedule below provides recommendations on when to order and administer a test, based on arrival date. Please email pgatour@vaulthealth.com to order a test kit. Please order TWO tests in case of an error and **indicate that you need the NAAT rapid test kit.**

Please pay close attention to the directions for submitting a Vault Lucira test kit:

- Vault Lucira at-home tests now **REQUIRE** live supervision; you will not receive results if you test without Vault supervision on Zoom
- Go to rapidtest.vaulthealth.com/pga to register your test kit. If you are asked to enter a company code, please enter PGA
- Meet with a Vault testing supervisor via Zoom call

- Please note: You do not need to schedule a supervised Zoom
- Hours for Vault Zoom are Sunday – Thursday 8 AM – 8 PM ET; Friday – Saturday 8 AM – 6 PM ET
- Provide sample and wait for results
- Results will appear on the testing device within 30 minutes
- You will receive an email when your result is ready

IMPORTANT: Vault Lucira tests do not need to be shipped back.

Returning to the Mainland:

- There is **NO** testing requirement to return to the U.S.
