NEED TO KNOW

- AVERAGE STROKE TIME (AST) is being recorded each week. At the conclusion of a tournament a player's average stroke
 time (AST) is compared against the field average. For a given tournament, if a player has an average stroke time of 7.0
 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an average stroke time (AST) infraction and will be notified via
 email on Monday or Tuesday following the tournament by the Competitions Department with additional details regarding
 the infraction. AST infractions are accumulated during the season before monetary fines are applied. Players can track their
 progress via the Player Links App. Instructional information to find their AST on the Links app can be found in the Bluesheet.
- PARKING NEAR #10 TEE is not available to players or caddies during tournament week. This parking lot is used for
 tournament purposes and evacuation. Parking along the adjacent neighborhood streets is not permitted and risks
 ticketing/towing by local law enforcement. Failure to adhere to this policy may result in disciplinary action.
- METAL SPIKES IN THE CLUBHOUSE are prohibited. Please remove any shoes that have metal spikes before walking inside.





- SHUTTLES TO #10 TEE will be available Monday-Wednesday at the times highlighted on the tournament week schedule below. During tournament rounds, players must be in the shuttle going to #10 tee 20 minutes prior to their starting time. Shuttles will be staged and only depart from the driveway adjacent to the practice facilities. Return shuttles for players concluding play on #9 will be available during applicable tournament rounds.
- PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play. Registration is located on the lower level of the clubhouse outside of the Men's Locker Room. Hours of operation are listed above.
- CLUB STORAGE is not available.
- LOCKER ROOM facilities and shoe cleaning service are available. Each player will have their own locker assigned by name plate, but keys will not be distributed. Neither the club nor the tournament are responsible for items left in the locker room. Locker Room Attendant hours will be the same as those listed above for practice facilities. Per KFT Rules and Regulations, golf bags may not be left in the locker room.
- PHYSICAL THERAPY is located in the lounge of the locker room. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PLAYER DINING** is located in the clubhouse and is open to players and a spouse/significant other with a TOUR issued credential ONLY. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the Clubhouse Parking Lot. You will be given one parking pass at registration to use for the week. Your TOUR issued credential will give you access the parking lot prior to registration.
- CADDIE DINING is located in the TPC Colorado Café inside the clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **CADDIE PARKING** is located in the Water Tower Lot on the north side of the clubhouse parking lot. You will be given one parking pass at registration to use for the week. Please identify yourself as a caddie prior to registering.
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies <u>MUST</u> use Committee approved yardage books since January 1, 2022.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **HERON LAKES JUNIOR PRO-AM** will take place on Monday, July 8th. There will be approximately 15 teams with starting times between 1:00 p.m. 3:30 p.m.
 - The 1st tee will re-open for practice rounds at approximately 4:00 p.m.
 - Shuttles will be available to the 4th tee and from the 13th green for players who wish to play holes #4 #13 during the Junior Pro-Am.
- OFFICIAL PRO-AM will take place on Wednesday, July 10th as a 9&9 format off #1 tee only with starting times between 6:30 a.m. 1:58 p.m. There will be approximately 40 teams.
 - o Per KFT regs, full-shots are permitted on 9-hole practice rounds before the pro-am until 6:15 a.m. on #1 tee and 8:15 a.m. on #10 tee.
 - 9-hole practice rounds are available off #1 tee from 2:30 p.m. 4:30 p.m. The last shuttle pick up at #9 green is 6:30 p.m.
 - Practice Range availability may be limited for those not in the pro-am between 6:00 a.m. 4:00 p.m.





- FITNESS CENTER is available for player use only and is located on the lower level of the clubhouse. Hours of operations will
 be the same as the practice facilities hours of operation listed above. Players must present their TOUR issued credential to
 gain access.
- **TICKETS** are available online for players and caddies to receive or send digitally by scanning the QR code below. There is a maximum of ten (10) any day tickets per transaction. Tickets are complimentary and the cost will be set to \$0 at checkout.

AGRONOMY

TPC Colorado has emerged from winter dormancy in good condition and is well-positioned for the event. The T-1 bentgrass greens are densely covered and are expected to provide firm, true putting surfaces. The tees, approaches, and fairways are in good condition, and with good weather advance and tournament weeks, will also provide firm playing conditions. All closely mown areas will be maintained similar to last year. The only change is the widening of #4 fairway.

Quick Facts:

- The greenspeed will be in the range of 11.0 feet.
- The tees and fairways and approaches will be mowed at 0.400 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.25 inches, and the primary rough will be maintained at 3.0 inches.
