ZOZO VISA INFORMATION

Representatives will be on-site Monday (1:00 PM to 4:30 PM), Tuesday and Wednesday (8:30 AM to 4:30 PM) in caddie dining during the Procore Championship to collect visa applications for the ZOZO Championship. Please note that you must have previously applied for the Certificate of Eligibility in order to receive an Entertainer visa for Japan. Please be prepared to bring the following with you to apply:

Visa Application (will be available on site) – Player/Caddie signature is required

Passport – these will be collected on site and submitted to the consulate with your application. Please be prepared to not have your passport available for a minimum of 10 days. If you plan to travel outside of the United States during this period, and you are a U.S. citizen, please contact Danyelle at danyelle@dashppv.com for options that may be available.

- Driver's License
- For International Players and Caddies- a copy of your P1 Visa Greencard or permanent resident information
- Photo will be taken on site
- Payment will be taken when you apply

For anyone not planning on being in Napa, please <u>FOLLOW THIS LINK</u> for information and instructions on how to apply. You will be required to send your passport, photos, and the visa documents to our agent, Danyelle Castro with DASH PPV via overnight delivery. The deadline for Danyelle to receive your documentation is no later than September 24th, 2024. If you are participating in the Presidents cup and do not have an additional passport, please contact Danyelle as soon as possible.
