### NEED TO KNOW

- **PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie Registration will be in the foyer next to the Golf Shop at the north end of the clubhouse closest to the practice range (hours listed above).
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** is **18-holes** and will take place on Wednesday, July 31<sup>st</sup> with 7:00 a.m. & 1:30 p.m. shotgun starts. There will be approximately 40 teams. Practice rounds will be available in the morning prior to the first starting time but the golf course must be clear by the 7:00 a.m. shotgun start. Practice rounds will **NOT** be permitted after the pro-am.

- **TICKETS** will be handled by the tournament office on Monday – Wednesday. Please see tournament office located in the Board Room of the clubhouse to provide requests. For ticket requests on Thursday – Sunday, please see Admissions Tent adjacent to the driving range.
- **PRIVATE HOUSING** is once again being offered to Korn Ferry Tour Professionals. This service will be provided based on availability and on a first come, first serve basis. - **PRACTICE RANGE** is limited to “Irons & Hybrids” ONLY. “Drivers & Fairway Woods” must be hit into the hitting nets on the range. Players are required to keep practice shots within the confines of the range. Players who do not keep practice shots within the confines of the range will lose their privilege to practice.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** will be available beginning Tuesday in the Ladies Card Room in the clubhouse. Please see physical therapy schedule (hours listed above).
- **FITNESS FACILITIES** are not available on site at Oakridge C.C.
- **PLAYER PARKING** is in the clubhouse parking lot at Oakridge Country Club which is limited. We encourage players and caddies to carpool throughout the week. Players must show their credential to gain initial parking access. Parking hang tags will be issued at registration and required the remainder of the week.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be in the Oak Room of the clubhouse and will be open to players and one guest (spouse or significant other) with credential issued by Korn Ferry Tour/PGA TOUR (hours listed above). Please see on-site Rules Office for spouse or significant other credentials, if needed.
- **LOCKER ROOM** facilities and shoe cleaning are available. Each player will have their own locker assigned by name plate, but keys will not be distributed. The club and the tournament are **NOT** responsible for items left in the locker room.
- **CLUB STORAGE** will not be available and golf bags are not permitted to be left in the locker room overnight.
- **CADDIE PARKING** is located at Knowlton Elementary School (801 Shepard Ln., Farmington, UT 84025) approximately a 1-mile shuttle ride from the clubhouse. The shuttles will begin at 6:00 a.m. Monday-Tuesday and 5:00 a.m. Wednesday - Friday. The last shuttle from the clubhouse will leave at 8:00 p.m. Monday - Friday and 6:00 p.m. Saturday - Sunday.
- **CADDIE DINING** will be in the Ballroom at the south end of the clubhouse. Please use the south clubhouse entrance near the pool. Entrance to this area is only permitted with a TOUR issued Caddie Credential received at registration this week (hours listed above).
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be available at Player/Caddie Registration. Yardage Books are complimentary. Players and caddies **MUST** use the 2022, 2023 or 2024 Rules Committee Approved Book.

## AGRONOMY

Oakridge Country Club has experienced a very hot and windy stretch leading into tournament week with forecasted high temperatures to continue in the mid to upper 90's. This additional stress on the playing surfaces, particularly the Poa annua greens, is being managed to yield the best possible playing surfaces. The Poa annua/Ryegrass tees, fairways and approaches are in good condition and are expected to play similarly to previous years. The cool-season blend of turf in the roughs is also in good shape and will be topped at 2.5 inches at the end of Advance Week, then left to grow through the event. There have been no changes made to the course since last year's event.

#### Quick Facts:

- The target green speed will be 11' to 11.5' – dependent on prevailing weather conditions.
- The tees, fairways and approaches will be mowed at .475 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1 inch, and the primary rough will be maintained at 2.5 inches.
