NEED TO KNOW

- **VIRTUAL LOCKER ROOM/LOCKER ROOM POSTING BOARDS** Each week the Rules Committee will prepare documents, notices and policies in these areas for your review. Posted documents will include tournament-specific information as well as Groupings, Pace of Play, Weather, etc. The Virtual Locker



Room is accessible via the PGA TOUR Central Platforms (Website or Mobile App). Posting Boards will be in a high-traffic area (i.e., Player Dining) when Locker Rooms are not available or accessible at host facilities.

- **PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie registration will be inside player dining gym area (hour listed above). Locker room facilities are available for all players in the field. \$20.00 USD (credit card) locker room fee will be collected at registration. Player lockers are located inside player dining area. Locker room services such as showers, towels and shoe cleaning will be available at the clubs' gentlemen main locker room.
- **CHILEAN TAX** please bring your passport to Player Registration as a representative from KPMG will be there to collect and file mandatory documentation needed for payouts.
- **PRINCE OF WALES COUNTRY CLUB CADDIES** The fee for use of a local caddie this week is a minimum of \$75 USD or 65.000 Chilean pesos per day, payable in cash (no checks). Please be clear with your caddie in advance about a percentage of payment if you make the cut. If you are bringing your own caddie, both player and caddie must register at player registration. If you need a local caddie and haven't completed the caddie questionnaire, please remember to do so prior to arrival.

Note: If you request a caddie and end up not using it without properly notifying the tournament or change caddies after the cut from a local to another, the local is to be paid in full or the applicable remaining days fees (\$75 USD or 65.000 Chilean pesos per day).

- **CLUB STORAGE** is secure and highly encouraged. Club storage is located behind the practice tee. Open 6:00am – 8:00pm.
- **YARDAGE or METERS BOOKS** will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies MUST use the 2023, 2024, 2025 or 2026 Committee Approved Book.
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will be conducted via tee times. 48 teams, 9 and 9 pro-am. Practice rounds will not be available if you are not in the Pro-Am on Wednesday. Players may chip and putt only in front of the first Pro-Am time on either nine.
- **UNOFFICIAL PRO-AM** will take place at 1:00 PM on Monday, shotgun start. If you have interest in playing, please contact Brad McGahey.
- **PRO-AM PRACTICE RANGE AND PRACTICE ROUNDS** practice range use for professionals not playing in the Pro-Am is prohibited during these hours: MONDAY 11:30 PM – 1:00 PM and WEDNESDAY 30 minutes before each wave for the length of the two waves to allow enough room for Pro-Am participants to warm up. Practice rounds are not permitted before or after the Pro-Am. Players may chip and putt only in front



of the first Pro-Am time on either nine.

- **GROUPINGS & STARTING TIMES** Will be made available on-site and distributed/posted electronically mid-day on Tuesday, February 3rd.
- **PLAYER DINING** Located in the gymnasium building is complimentary for players and players spouses/significant other (hours listed above). Players and players guests will be able to pay to access player dining. Breakfast 30 USD and Lunch 44 USD for one time serving (credit card only). Tour credential or applicable photo ID will be required to access player dining area. Complimentary dining will only include one time serving. Please be advised that the tournament will take measures to ensure this is enforced so be conscious and respectful of it. Guests can also make use of PWCC dining areas.
- **CADDIE DINING** Complimentary caddie dining will be provided at the “Quincho” left of the 10th hole. Caddies will also have the option of paying for player dining. Breakfast 30 USD and Lunch 44 USD for one time serving (credit card only) or use any of PWCC dining areas.
- **PRACTICE RANGE** Due to driving range dimensions, players are required to keep balls inside the netting. Violators will be subject to disciplinary action. Hours of operation listed above. Please note hours closed prior to Pro-Ams.
- **FITNESS/TRAINING FACILITY** Club facilities available and open Tuesday to Friday 7:00 AM – 10:00 PM and Saturday / Sunday 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM. Located downstairs from player dining.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** Available inside the GYM / locker room area (hours listed above).
- **TICKETS:** Please contact the Tournament Director Lukas Peric via email (listed above) or visit the Tournament Office located upstairs on the second floor of the Club House as you enter the building.
- **AIRPORT / HOST HOTEL TRANSPORTATION**

The bentgrass putting greens have endured an extremely hot and dry summer in acceptable condition with minor imperfections. Conservative grooming practice advance week should help produce smooth putting surfaces at desired speed. The bermudagrass tees, fairways, and approaches are in good condition and will remain firm throughout the competition. The mostly bermudagrass rough adjacent to the fairways is thick and dense and will be cut at 2.5-inches, as will the mixed cool season rough underneath the numerous trees. Target greens speed for competition rounds will be approximately 12 feet.
