Practice Policy



During practice rounds, the following shall govern certain types of strokes:

- 1. Only one stroke, including a stroke from a bunker, may be aimed for the putting green, except as follows:
 - a. If such a stroke does not stop on a putting green, <u>one</u> additional stroke may be played.
 - b. More than one chip shot outside a bunker may be played provided such practice does not damage the course.
- 2. Not more than three bunker strokes may be played in directions other than toward a putting green provided the bunker is not damaged unduly.
- 3. More than one stroke may be played on a putting green.

In any case, a player must not delay any following players. Specifically, and notwithstanding any to the contrary herein, any time when a member of a group behind the player is waiting to play a stroke, no practice strokes shall be permitted.

During practice periods for qualified players and the first ten alternates for the tournament, other players shall not practice on the tournament course. Eligible players and the first ten alternates shall not practice with ineligible players.

PRACTICE SHALL BE PERMITTED ON DESIGNATED PRACTICE AREAS ONLY

Before a Round

A player shall practice only on designated practice areas or chip and putt on or near the first teeing area.

During a Round

A player, <u>without undue delay</u>, <u>after finishing the hole</u>, may chip and putt on or near the teeing area of the next hole to be played or on any practice putting green.

During Suspension of Play

A player shall practice only on designated practice areas. During suspension for a dangerous situation, all practice areas will remain closed until opened by a Korn Ferry Tour Rules Official.
