

Official Two Day (Tuesday & Wednesday) 9&9 Pro-Am

OVERVIEW

Overview:

- The official tournament pro-am will be staged on Tuesday and Wednesday of tournament week.
- Professionals will play 9 holes, with the option to play 18 holes.
- Amateurs will play the first 9 holes with one professional and the second 9 holes with another professional unless paired with a professional designated to play 18 holes.

Q&A

- Can I choose the day that I play?
 - No, players cannot request which day they want to participate. Assignments are based on rank based off prior year FedExCup Fall Points List. Should players need to switch, they must request to do so through the Chief Rules Official.
- When do I find out which day I'm playing?
 - A list of players eligible/selected plus alternates for the Pro-Am will be posted on PGA TOUR Links at the **commitment deadline**. Posting will denote which day (Tuesday or Wednesday) players are playing in the pro-am or potential alternate assignments.
- When will the Pro-Am times be posted?
 - Both Pro-Am draws will be posted by mid-morning on Monday.
- Can I practice before or after the Pro-Ams?
 - Subject to daylight, players may be able to practice before and after the Pro-Ams. Please refer to the official notice boards for exact practice times.
- What are the perceived benefits of Tuesday/Wednesday Pro-Am?
 - Offers a more balanced Pro-Am/practice schedule for players
 - Time available for those not in the respective Pro-Ams to practice on Tuesday and Wednesday
 - Improved on-site experience for players and amateurs
 - Favorable tee times to avoid finishing late or in darkness
 - Reduces the likelihood of significant delays for turn groups

Standard Pro-Am / Sponsor Function Composition:

- 48 Teams / 96 professional time slots
 - 24 Teams (48 professionals) on Tuesday / 24 Teams (48 professionals) on Wednesday
 - Where a player decides to play all 18 holes, the respective professional allocation will be reduced by 1
- 10 sponsor selections (9 holes only)
 - 6 sponsor exemptions Tuesday / 4 sponsor exemptions Wednesday
 - If pro-am consists of less than 18 teams, the sponsor picks will be reduced by 2
- 12 alternates
 - Pro-Am is posted with alternates assigned
 - Highest ranking six players not in the pro-am shall be designated for 9-holes on Wednesday in the first wave (1,3,5) and turn wave (2,4,6), followed by remaining six alternates for 9-holes on Tuesday in the first wave (7,9,11) and turn wave (8,10,12).
- 8 Sponsor Function and 5 Next in line for obligation, 8 Sponsor Function sponsor function

Pro-Am Ordering:

- 10 sponsor selections (6 Tuesday / 4 Wednesday)
 - Tournaments may select up to 2 players as sponsor selections for the pro-am that are already a part of the pro-am field and elevate them to a sponsor selection pro-am time. Each of these

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selections will reduce the tournament's total number of pro-am sponsor selections by 1.

(Note: Tournaments may not utilize a sponsor selection to move a player from his preferred tee time or assigned day.)

- Hall of Fame and Life Members will receive first preference
- Following the above, professional players will be assigned day and time preference via their order on the previous season's FedExCup Fall points list to a floor of 150th position, and thereafter, based upon the current season's FedExCup points list as of 2 weeks prior to tournament week.
 - Wednesday pro-am times off #1 and #10 and turn times will be filled first followed by Tuesday pro-am times off #1 and #10 and turn times.
- Assignments for the pro-ams are completed by taking the the highest ranked player assigned to the first 9 holes pairing them with the first player assigned to the second 9 holes and so on down the list (i.e. #1 and #23 together, #22 and #46 together).

Contingency Plan for Weather:

- In the event of bad weather of another unforeseen circumstance, the starting times may be moved earlier or later to accommodate the situation, even if this means utilizing time reserved for practice rounds.
- Should the pro-am be reduced to 9 holes for one or both segments, priority for play will fall to the professionals playing the first 9 holes off #1 and #10 on both days. Players scheduled for the second 9 holes will be released or consideration should be given to adding second nine pros to first nine pros teams to create teams of 5. Players must retain same starting tee.
- If the Tuesday pro-am is lost due to weather or another unforeseen circumstance, play will not carry over into Wednesday.

Wednesday Pro-Am player preference/assignment:

Pro Assignments for up to 24 teams on Wednesday (2 pro per team /48 total players):

- Top 48 available PGA TOUR members, based off prior year FedExCup Fall Points List
- 4 Sponsor Picks
- 6 Alternates
 - alternates are the next six players after those eligible for the pro-ams

Tuesday Pro-Am player preference/assignment:

Pro Assignments for up to 24 teams on Tuesday (2 pros per team / 48 total players):

- Top 48 available PGA TOUR members, based off prior year FedExCup Fall Points List. Should the pro-am not be filled, the current season's FedExCup points list will be used until all positions are filled
- 6 Sponsor Picks
- 6 Alternates
 - alternates are the next six players after those eligible for the pro-ams and Wednesday alternates
