NEED TO KNOW

- REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play. Player Registration will be located in the Members Lounge & Caddie Registration will be located in the Ballroom (Volunteer & Caddie HQ). Hours of operation are listed above. Locker room fee is \$20 and club repair fee is \$15.
- PHYSICAL THERAPY is located in the Member's Lounge, where Player Registration and Scoring will be located.
- CLUB STORAGE is not available.
- LOCKER ROOM facilities and shoe cleaning are available. Each player will have their own locker assigned by name plate, but keys will not be distributed. Golf Bags may NOT be left in the Locker Room overnight.







<u>Neither the club or the tournament</u> are responsible for items left in the locker room. Locker Room Attendants hours will be 7:00 am - 7:00 pm daily.

- **FITNESS CENTER** is not available at The Glen Club. A nearby alternative, low cost (\$10/day or \$20/week) option will be available. Information to be available at Player Registration.
- MONDAY PRO-AM There will be a field of approximately 28 teams for the RSM Pro-Am. Play will be off #1 & #10 from 12:00 pm 2:10 pm. Practice rounds are available off #1 and #10 tees beginning at 7:00 am. No play may begin off Hole #1 or #10 after 11:30 am. 1st & 10th tees will be available again at 5:00 pm, play must remain one hole behind the Pro-Am.
- OFFICIAL PRO-AM The Hometown Brands Pro-Am will take place on Wednesday, July 24th as a 9 & 9 format with starting times from approximately 6:45 am to 8:57 am and 12:10 pm to 2:27 pm. There will be a field of approximately 52 teams. 9-hole practice rounds will be available from #1 and #10 tees until 6:30 am and must NOT interfere with the Pro-Am. Practice rounds are NOT permitted after the official pro-am.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on Hole #10 must yield to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds already in progress. Abuse of Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- MEDICAL First Aid/EMS is located on-site all week, in the parking lot. An on-call doctor will be available to players all week.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the main clubhouse parking lot. Players will receive a Lot A parking pass at Player Registration that must be displayed to park in Lot A.
- PLAYER DINING will be located on the main level of the clubhouse, in the Grill Room, and will be open to players and one spouse/significant other (including children) with a TOUR issued credential (hours listed above). NOTE: Additional player family will be able to purchase daily dining passes for \$40/day at the Front Desk located in the Clubhouse Lobby.
- CADDIE PARKING is located in Lot B, directly adjacent to The Glen Club clubhouse. Access to Lot B is at the intersection of Lake Ave and Valor Drive, just east of the clubhouse parking lot. Parking pass will be required and is obtained at Caddie Registration.
- CADDIE DINING will be located on the main level of the clubhouse, in the Ballroom (hours listed above).
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be available free of charge at Player and Caddie Registration. Players and caddies
 <u>MUST</u> use the 2022, 2023 or 2024 Committee Approved Books.
- SHORT GAME AREA at the back of the range, is available for use by players. The tee deck adjacent to the Short Game Area is closed, and not available for use. Any use of this tee will be subject to disciplinary action.







- SHUTTLES TO #10 TEE will be available from the back of the Practice Range, Monday-Friday at the times highlighted on the tournament week schedule below. Players should allow ample time to arrive at the 10th tee for their starting time. Return shuttles for players concluding play on #9 will be available during applicable tournament rounds.
- TICKETS are available to players upon request at Player Registration.
- MAIL is deliverd to The Glen Club Pro Shop.

AGRONOMY

Golf Course Superintendent: Adam Wiles PGA TOUR Agronomist: PJ Ringenberger

The Glen Club experienced a mild winter and early spring which has advanced the golf course turf growth sooner than usual, providing good conditions moving into the summer golf season. The bentgrass greens are in great shape with excellent density and smoothness. The tees, fairways, and approaches are all in good shape and will provide consistent lies throughout the facility. The bluegrass rough provides a consistent playing area which will be maintained at 3" during advance week and then allowed to grow during the event. The original bunkers on the property show their age. When dry, the bunkers prepare nicely and the playability is good, but during rainy weather, the bunkers have difficulty draining and tend to stay wet. The club will undergo a bunker renovation starting in September of this year.

Quick Facts:

- The greenspeed will be in the range of 12 12.5 feet.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.450 inch.
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.500 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.25 inches, and the primary rough will be maintained at 3 inches.
