NEED TO KNOW

- OFFICIAL PRO-AM is <u>9 & 9</u> format on Wednesday August 13th. There will be 54 teams. Practice rounds are available on Wednesday prior to the Pro Am only.
- PRACTICE TEE is limited to 220 yard maximum distance. All Drivers and Fairway woods MUST be hit into the
 hitting nets on the practice tee, along with any shots with over 220 yards. This is for the safety of players and
 spectators on holes #10 & #11, and disregard for their safety will not be tolerated. Players not abiding by this
 will lose





practice tee access for the remainder of the week and be subject to Disciplinary Action in accordance with Korn Ferry Tour Rules & Regulations.

- PLAYER REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play; Player Registration will be located in the Ladies Locker Room. Hours of operation are listed above.
- CADDIE REGISTRATION is located inside the Ladies Locker Room. Hours of operations are listed above.
- PHYSICAL THERAPY is located in the Mens Locker Room Lounge.
- GYM ACCESS is available on-site in the clubhouse. Available daily from 5:30 AM 8:00 PM
- MASSAGE THERAPY is available on-site in physio with limited availability. See the sign up sheet in Physio.
 Services provided complimentary thanks to Saint Adolphus.
- TICKETS Players can request up to 2 tickets per player for family and friends. Tickets can be picked up in the
 Tournament Office, located left of the short game area. These tickets will provide access to concerts, as will
 Player and Spouse credentials.
- LOCKER ROOM/CLUB STORAGE Locker Room is available this week, but players are prohibited from leaving their clubs in the Locker Room overnight. There is no bag storage available this week.
- **PLAYER DINING** is located in the clubhouse in the 19th Hole and is open to players and their spouse/significant other and children with TOUR issued credentials. Hours of operation are listed above.
- PLAYER PARKING will be located in the clubhouse parking lot. Due to limited parking, it is encouraged for
 players and caddies to carpool when possible.
- CADDIE PARKING is located in LOT D.
- CADDIE DINING is located in the temporary structure in the parking lot next to the 18th green. See Breakfast & Lunch schedules above.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on Hole #10 must yield to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds already in progress. Abuse of Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies
 <u>MUST</u> use the 2022, 2023, 2024 or 2025 Committee Approved Book.
- PARFOUR STREAMING PLATFORM will be conducting a private streaming test this week. Parfour is a streaming
 platform designed to provide professional-quality coverage to golf tournaments. The Parfour team (two cameras
 and additional support staff) will be on-site Saturday and Sunday, covering the tournament as part of a test to
 evaluate the platform's production and operational capabilities in a live tournament setting. We will send more
 details and information to the field on Monday.

PGA TOUR Agronomist: Thomas Bastis

Following a relatively typical winter and a slightly warmer-than-average spring, Hillcrest Country Club enters the 2025 event in excellent agronomic condition. The bentgrass/Poa annua greens are dense, firm, and healthy—expected to deliver smooth, consistent putting surfaces that match or exceed previous years' standards. The cool-season turf in the tees, fairways, and rough exhibits strong density and uniform coverage, supported by solid root development and proactive conditioning throughout the spring.

Ongoing refinement of the irrigation system and continued tree canopy management have helped optimize light, airflow, and moisture distribution across key playing areas. The club's attention to detail is evident throughout the property, reflecting a strong agronomic program and daily commitment to tournament-level conditions.





Quick Facts:

- Greenspeed will be in the 12+' range, as weather conditions allow.
- Tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.425".
- Fairways will be mowed at 0.450".
- Intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.50", and the primary rough will be maintained at 3+
