### NEED TO KNOW

- PRO-AM OPT-OUTS** are not available to players, regardless of membership status, in Official Pro-Ams in the Korn Ferry Tour Finals events per Korn Ferry Tour Tournament Regulations. Please see below for additional information specific to this week's Pro-Am.
- THE 13<sup>TH</sup> HOUR** is a tradition held daily at The Patriot Golf Club. Please note each day at 1:00 p.m. (1300 hours) Taps is played from atop the Sierra Hotel (building adjacent to #9 green and golf shop) and the bells will chime thirteen times, each time to represent a fold in the American Flag that creates the iconic triangle shape. While this cannot be heard from everywhere on the golf course, it will be prominent around the clubhouse area, practice facilities and nearby holes to the clubhouse. It will take approximately 2-minutes to complete.
- MILITARY FLYOVER (FRIDAY)** in conjunction with Folds of Honor Friday will be held during the second round. There will be a military flyover and moment of silence at 12:55 p.m. NOTE: This will be televised, so please note that you may be on camera.

- **CEREMONIAL FIRST TEE SHOT** to kick-off the championship will be conducted on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee prior to the start of round one at approximately 7:00 a.m. Alan Bratton (Oklahoma State Men's Head Golf Coach) will hit the opening tee shot.
- **FOLDS OF HONOR FRIDAY OPENING CEREMONY** will take place on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee prior to the start of round two at approximately 7:00 a.m. The ceremony will include the playing of the National Anthem, presentation of colors and an honorary first tee shot by Lt. Col. Dan Rooney, founder and CEO of Folds of Honor.
- **DR. JULIE AMATO** will be on-site at the Compliance Solutions Championship. Please click the link ahead to schedule time to meet with her. [Click Here to Schedule](#)
- **REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play. Player and Caddie Registration will be located inside the clubhouse in the main foyer (main entrance of clubhouse). Hours of operation are listed above.
- **TICKETS** for general admission will be provided complimentary to players and caddies at registration (via a QR code). Any ticket requests after registration can be made at this same location inside the clubhouse via Player Services, open Thursday-Sunday from 7:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
- **LOCKER ROOM** will be available this week. Each player will have their own locker assigned by name plate, but keys will not be distributed. Neither the club nor the tournament are responsible for items left in the locker room. NOTE: The Men's Locker Room is located next to the golf shop, this is a separate building adjacent to the clubhouse and practice putting green. This room will be locked overnight and open daily from 5:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. The locker room has showers, bathrooms, shoe cleaning and even a speakeasy bar available inside.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is not available.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** will be located in the Women's Locker Room (located across from the Men's Locker Room). Hours of operation are listed above.
- **EQUIPMENT DISTRIBUTION** will be in the Men's Locker Room.
- **PLAYER & CADDIE PARKING** will both be located in the clubhouse parking lot. Limited parking is available. Players and caddies are encouraged to carpool as much as possible. NOTE: Players and caddies will each be provided only one (1) tournament parking pass at registration and will be required to use this pass for entry. Please be aware The Patriot Golf Club is located within a neighborhood that has a gated security checkpoint. Players and caddies will gain free access through this security checkpoint upon first arrival. After you have registered, you must use your parking pass to gain access for the remainder of the tournament.
- **FAMILY/FRIENDS/SPECTATOR ACCESS** will not be permitted to park in the clubhouse parking lot regardless of credential. The gates will be closed to the public all day Monday-Wednesday. Public parking is available Thursday-Sunday at Stone Canyon Park. This is located across the street from Stone Canyon Elementary at 7410 N. 117<sup>th</sup> E. Ave | Owasso, OK 74055 (5-minutes from The Patriot Golf Club). Complimentary shuttle service will be running during all hours of operation Thursday-Sunday. NOTE: Player agents will still have access to the club and clubhouse parking Monday-Wednesday (agents need to provide their TOUR issued credential at the security gate).
- **PLAYER DINING** will be located inside the clubhouse in the Meshri Family Dining room. Please refer to the tournament page on PGATOURLinks.com for player dining menu's during the week. Player dining will be open only to players and one (1) spouse/significant other with a TOUR issued credential. Hours of operation listed above. NOTE: Please be advised metal spikes are not allowed in the clubhouse, as they will damage the hardwood floors.

- **CADDIE DINING** will be located inside the clubhouse in the Sisemore Saloon. Hours of operation listed above.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be provided complimentary to all players and caddies at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use the 2025 Rules Committee Approved Book.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **NORTH END OF DRIVING RANGE** is closed to players and caddies for safety reasons.
- **MONDAY PRO-AM** is a shotgun start at 1:00 p.m. This 18-hole pro-am will consist of approximately 8 teams comprised of 1 professional and 4 amateurs. Holes 1-9 will be used to begin play. All practice round groups must be clear of holes 1-9 by 1:00 p.m. The course will be available for practice rounds all day – working around the holes that are occupied by the pro-am.
- **PRO-AM PAIRINGS PARTY** will take place Tuesday, September 30 from 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. Located in the Founder's Hall room inside the clubhouse at The Patriot Golf Club. All players are invited to join for a night of food, drinks and mingling with pro-am participants.
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will take place on Wednesday, October 1 as a 9&9 format with starting times from approximately 7:25 a.m. – 9:35 a.m. and 12:35 p.m. – 2:25 p.m. There will be approximately 52 teams comprised of 1 professional and 4 amateurs.
  - Eligibility based off KFT Points List at the conclusion of Nationwide Children's Hospital Championship.
  - Per KFT Regs, Pro-Am Opt-Outs may not be used during Korn Ferry Tour Finals events, regardless of membership status.
  - Practice rounds are **not** permitted before or after this pro-am, but players are allowed to walk the golf course and may chip and putt only ahead of the first starting time.
- **GYM ACCESS** is not available at The Patriot Golf Club and will not be provided off-site.
- **FOLDS OF HONOR BENEFIT CONCERT** will be held on Thursday, October 2 at Hard Rock Live in Catoosa (located 15-minutes from The Patriot Golf Club). Corey Kent will be performing. A limited number of tickets are reserved for player and caddies and their family. The tickets are non-transferable and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Please fill out a request form at registration if you are interested to get tickets.
- **PRIVATE HOUSING** is available, with host houses conveniently located nearby in the Stone Canyon neighborhood. - The course will be available for practice rounds ALL DAY – working around the holes that are occupied by the pro-am. All practice round groups must be clear of holes 1-9 by 1:00 p.m.

## **AGRONOMY**

Despite a challenging summer, The Patriot Golf Club is in good condition. A few fairways have sodded areas, and the recent rainfall has exposed some consistently wet spots. However, with a favorable weather forecast during advance week and tournament week – temperatures expected in the high 70s to low 80s – these areas should not pose any concern. The new cart paths on holes 4 and 14 have proven to be excellent additions, with the turf responding positively. Additional cart paths are needed for the remainder of hole 4 and all of hole 5, as these fairways still require better conditioning and coverage. The A1/A4 bentgrass greens are in relatively good shape, with no loss of hole locations. Although there are numerous ball marks and a few stressed areas around the perimeter of some greens, we are actively working to improve these conditions. The tees are well-maintained with good density.

Quick Facts:

- The target green speed will be 11.5-12.0 feet.

- The zoysiagrass tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.500 inches. Zoysiagrass fairways will be mowed at 0.575 inches. There is no intermediate rough, and the primary rough will be 2.5+inches. NOTE: Some bunker surrounds feature a natural grass with variable height-of-cut at 3+inches.

## **KORN FERRY TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP – IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW**

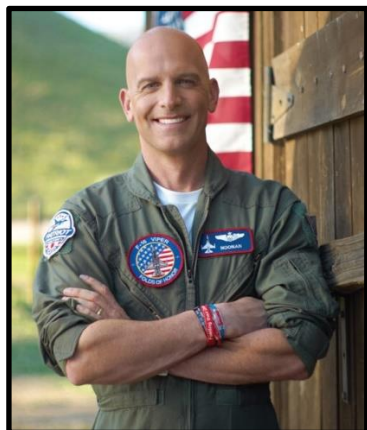
- OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will take place on both Tuesday, October 7 and Wednesday, October 8 with the field divided by priority ranking. Players ranked 12-22 and 34-44 on the Official Korn Ferry Tour Points List at the conclusion of the Compliance Solutions Championship will play on Tuesday, October 7. Players ranked 1-11 and 23-33 will play on Wednesday, October 8. There will be 4 sponsor picks for each day. Please plan travel accordingly. As a reminder, per KFT Regs, Pro-Am Opt-Outs may not be used during Korn Ferry Tour Finals events.
- GROUPINGS** for Round 1 will be based off the Official Korn Ferry Tour Points List at the conclusion of the Compliance Solutions Championship, with players being re-grouped following each of the first, second and third round by score. Groupings predicated on the Korn Ferry Tour Points List will be segmented to accommodate certain positions playing within the television window. For each round of the competition, it is anticipated that tee times and groupings will be structured off one tee and in groups of three, unless circumstances (i.e., weather) are no longer suitable to achieve this.
