NEED TO KNOW

- VIRTUAL LOCKER ROOM/LOCKER ROOM POSTING BOARDS Each week the Rules Committee will prepare
 documents, notices and policies in these areas for your review. Posted documents will include tournamentspecific information as well as Groupings, Pace of Play, Weather, etc. The Virtual Locker Room is accessible via
 PGA TOUR Links Platforms (Website or Mobile App). Posting Boards will be located in a high-traffic area (i.e., Player
 Dining) when Locker Rooms are not available or accessible at host facilities.
- PLAYER/CADDIE REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie Registration will be
 located at The Cliff House Restaurant by 18 Green (New for 2025) on site at the Abaco Club. Golf cart shuttles will be
 provided from the welcome center and Flippers. Hours of operation are listed above.
- THURSDAY PRO AM There is a shotgun Pro-Am at 11:30 am. Practice play must be completed on the first 14 holes by 11:00 am. Practice rounds will be available during the gap in the pro-am.

- OFFICIAL (SATURDAY) PRO-AM is 9&9 and will take place Saturday, January 18th with first nine starting times from approximately 7:00 am 12:30 pm (first tee only). Second nine tee times from approximately 9:30 am 3:30 pm off the 10th tee. There will be approximately 30 teams. There will be no practice round availability off #1 tee prior to the Pro-Am. The 10th tee will be open for practice rounds from 6:45 am 9:00 am. The first tee will open for practice rounds following the pro-am from approximately 1:00 pm 3:30 pm. The practice range will be closed to non-Pro-Am professionals from 9:30 am- 12:30 pm.
- **GROUPINGS & STARTING TIMES** will be made available on-site and distributed/posted electronically mid-day on Friday, January 17th.
- TICKETS Physical tickets will be available at the tournament office.
- PLAYER/CADDIE PARKING will be available in the staff parking lot just past the main entrance on the right (New parking lot for 2025). Overflow parking is available on the street adjacent to the parking lot.
- PLAYER DINING is located at The Cliff House Restaurant, open to players and spouses/significant others. Hours of operation are listed above.
- CADDIE DINING is complimentary and located at Flippers/Beach House Restaurant adjacent to #1 tee. Hours of
 operation are listed above.
- LOCKER ROOM/CLUB STORAGE locker room facilities are unavailable. Bag storage is secure and available next to the pro shop.
- FITNESS CENTER facilities are available on site on the lower level of the Spa next to the Cliff house.
- CHIROPRACTOR/PHYSICAL THERAPY is located in the Fitness Center on the lower level of the Spa next to the Cliff House. Medics will be onsite.

Agronomy Report:

The Bahamas Great Abaco Classic at The Abaco Club

Golf Course Superintendent: Matt DiMase

PGA TOUR Agronomist: Alex Stuedemann, CGCS

The Abaco Club is ready for the upcoming event, thanks to sound agronomics and a mild hurricane season. The SeaDwarf Paspalum greens are in good condition, with minor issues on hole #s 4, 17, and 18 that are being addressed in advance with additional fertility and plugging. The closely mown surfaces established with SeaIsle Supreme Paspalum are generally strong, though some effects from seasonal winds and sea spray will be managed over the coming weeks. The mix of warm-season turfgrasses in the rough will provide a dense border against the natural sandy areas. For 2025, an expanded and re-grassed putting green near the 1st tee and the new Diablo putting course will be introduced, both expected to match the quality of the on-course greens.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be 10.5' with any adjustments dictated by forecasted winds.
- The tees, fairways, and approaches will be moved at 0.400".
- The primary rough will be maintained at 2.50" with no intermediate cut.
