NEED TO KNOW

- AVERAGE STROKE TIME (AST)** is being recorded each week. At the conclusion of a tournament, a player’s Average Stroke Time (AST) is compared against the field average. For a given tournament, if a player has an average stroke time of 7.0 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an Average Stroke Time (AST) infraction. Additionally, for a given tournament if a player has an average stroke time of 12.0 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an Excessive Average Stroke Time (EAST) infraction. Players who receive an AST or EAST will be notified via email on Monday or Tuesday following the tournament by the Competitions Department with additional details regarding the infraction. AST infractions (including those deemed excessive) are accumulated during the season before monetary fines are applied. Players can track their progress via the Player Links App. Instructional information to find their AST on the Links app can be found in the Bluesheet.



- **DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES** will be allowed for use during the competition. The Rules Committee recommends all players and caddies choose a traditional rangefinder-style instrument for **measuring distance only**. All other features such as course mapping, club selection advice, and measuring slope/elevation/wind **MUST** be disabled prior to using the device during competition. If such features cannot be disabled, the device must not be used. The penalty for the first breach of this rule is two-strokes. A second breach results in disqualification from the competition. For questions regarding your distance-measuring device, please seek an on-site member of the Rules Committee.
- **NEW PACE OF PLAY POLICY** is in effect this week. This new policy removes one step before reaching the application of a penalty stroke when a player receives a Bad Time. Under the new policy, if a player that is being timed exceeds the applicable time to play a stroke (i.e. Bad Time) they will now receive a one-stroke penalty for the first offense, a two-stroke penalty for a second offense, and disqualification for a third offense. The Bad Times will carry over to subsequent rounds during the competition. For any requests regarding this pace-of-play policy, please seek an on-site member of the Rules Committee.
- **REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie Registration will be located inside the clubhouse in the main foyer, accessible through the front doors of the clubhouse and adjacent to the golf shop. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **LAUNDRY SERVICE** will be provided to players and caddies in collaboration with Speedy Clean Laundry. More information will be provided at Player Registration.
 - Speedy Clean Laundry staff will be on-site, laundry drop-off is located in the main foyer by registration
 - Tuesday, April 22 at 4:00 p.m. is the final drop-off time
 - Wednesday, April 23 at 10:00 a.m. is laundry pick-up time
 - Players and caddies will be charged \$1.49 per pound

- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** will be located inside the clubhouse, in the “Right Field” portion of the main banquet room. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **TICKETS** are available digitally and can be requested at registration or at player services. Player services will remain in the same area as registration and be available Monday-Sunday from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is not available.
- **LOCKER ROOM** facilities are not available.



- **EQUIPMENT DISTRIBUTION** will be at the equipment trailers located at the driving range.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the clubhouse parking lot, which is limited. We encourage players and caddies to carpool throughout the week. Players must show their credential to gain parking access each day.
- **PLAYER DINING** is located inside the clubhouse, main restaurant area, and will be open to players and one guest (spouse or significant other) with a TOUR issued credential. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **CADDIE PARKING** will be off-site at the Texas Rangers Prius LOT F, located just south of the intersection at I-30 and AT&T Way (2-miles from the golf course). The address is 1550 Convention Center Drive and caddies should enter off AT&T Way. There is a sign that says "PRIUS LOT F" where you enter. If you do not see this sign off AT&T Way, you are at the wrong entrance. Complimentary shuttle service will be provided daily beginning at 5:30 AM Monday-Wednesday, and beginning at 5:00 AM Thursday-Sunday. Shuttles will operate every 30 minutes. Please allow for a 15-20 minute travel time to get to the golf course.
- **CADDIE DINING** is located inside the clubhouse, main restaurant area (player and caddie dining will share the same space). Hours of operation are listed above (same operating times as Player Dining).
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be provided complimentary to all players and caddies at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use the Rules Committee Approved Book since January 1, 2022.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **JUNIOR PRO-AM** will take place on Monday, April 21 beginning at 4:00 p.m. (shotgun start on the front nine). The front nine will close at 4:00 p.m. All players must be off the front nine by this time.
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will take place on Wednesday, April 23 as a 9&9 format with starting times between approximately 7:45 a.m. to 9:24 a.m. and 12:45 p.m. to 2:24 p.m. There will be approximately 40 teams. Per Korn Ferry Tour Regs, full-shots are permitted on 9-hole practice rounds before the Pro-Am.
- **GYM ACCESS** is not available on property at Texas Rangers Golf Club. However, complimentary gym access will be available to players off-site at Inner Strength Fitness, located 1-mile from the golf course at 1831 Brown Blvd, UNIT 105. Players will need to schedule workouts in advance. To do so, please contact Jesse Jackson at (682) 238-9489.

AGRONOMY

Golf Course Superintendent: Justin Allen

Texas Rangers Golf Club executed another solid greens overseed, resulting in consistent and dense surfaces. The overseeded tees, fairways, and approaches lack 100% turfgrass coverage and present moderate ryegrass coverage with a few historical bare areas of turf, which will benefit from an emerging bermudagrass base during competition. The non-overseeded rough should break dormancy near advance week and is expected to perform similarly to previous years. Due to significant play leading up to the event, ball marks and divots may be present in some areas. The new Superintendent, Justin Allen, has significantly improved overall course health, turfgrass coverage, and bunker conditioning while completing \$470,000 in course repairs and upgrades.

Quick Facts:

- The greenspeed will be in the range of 11.0 – 11.5 feet.
- The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at 0.400 inches.
- There is no intermediate rough; the primary rough will be maintained at 1.5 inches.
