#### **NEED TO KNOW**

- **REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play; Player & Caddie Registration will be located just outside Player Locker Room. Hours of operation are listed above. Locker room fee is \$20 and club repair fee is \$15.
- PHYSICAL THERAPY is located in the Locker Room second level Hours of operation are listed above.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is not available.
- LOCKER ROOM facilities will be available. Each player has an assigned locker with nameplate.
- MONDAY PRO-AM will take place on Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup>. There will be a 18-hole shotgun start at 9:00 a.m. with a field of approximately 28 teams. Practice rounds are available before, however you need to be off





the course by 8:30 am. Practice rounds will be available after the Pro-Am at approximately 3pm.

- OFFICIAL PRO-AM will take place on Wednesday, July 19<sup>th</sup> as a 9&9 scramble format with starting times 6:45 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. There will be a full field of 52 teams. Practice rounds are NOT available after the Official Pro-Am.
- **GYM ACCESS** will be available at CoxHealth Fitness Center, 3545 South National Ave. To gain access, you must present your Tour Credential. Hours: Mon-Thur: 5 am 9 pm; Fri: 5 am 8 pm; Sat, Sun: 6 am 5 pm.
- TICKETS are available at registration.
- **FISHING CONTEST** presented by Bass Pro Shops will take place immediately following the conclusion of play from the competition rounds.
- MAIL & PACKAGES All packages will be delivered to the Highland Springs Pro Shop.
- MEDICAL First aid will be available everyday at Highland Springs Country Club. EMS is on site, located near
  cart barn and volunteer tent. First Aid is in the Tennis Office.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the main golf course parking lot. Players must show their Tour-issued Credential to Security at the Main Gate.
- PLAYER DINING will be located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Level of the clubhouse outside of Player Locker Room. Refer to
  the tournament page on <u>PGATOURLinks.com</u> for player dining menus for Monday Sunday.
  Note: Player dining will be open to players and their spouse/significant other ONLY with a TOUR-issued
  credential. Hours of operation are listed above.
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be available at Player/Caddie Registration. Players and caddies <u>MUST</u> use the 2022 or 2023 Committee Approved Book.
- **CADDIE PARKING** is available in the General Parking by the Hall of Fame.
- CADDIE DINING is complimentary, entrance is at the west end of clubhouse (near #10 tee). Same hours of
  operation as above. Note: Players do not have access to Caddie Dining and must use Player Dining ONLY.
- CADDIE BADGES AND ACCESS registration is located through the glass door on the lower level next to
  Player Dining. After registration, caddies will only have access to the locker room through the back
  stairwell located next to the tennis courts and caddie dining on the opposite end of the clubhouse.

Highland Springs Country Club is well-positioned for the upcoming Price Cutter Charity Championship. Consistent with prior years, the A-1/A-4 creeping bentgrass greens are in good condition and will be maintained to produce smooth ball roll yet may be receptive due to the high heat and humidity in Springfield. The warm-season Meyer zoysiagrass tees, fairways, and approaches have good density and are expected to provide ideal summer playing conditions. Given the July timing, the cool-season rough height and density will be largely dependent on temperature and rainfall leading into tournament week. No competitive changes were made since last year's event.

#### **Quick Facts:**

• The target greenspeed will be 11'- 12'.





- The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at .475 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.5 inches, and the primary rough will be maintained at 3.5 inches weather dependent.
