NEED TO KNOW

- OFFICIAL PRO-AM** is **18 holes** on Wednesday August 21st. There will be 54 teams split between 7:30 AM and 1:30 PM shotguns. Practice rounds are unavailable on Wednesday. Per Korn Ferry Tour Rules & Regulations, Pro-Am outs may not be used in the Korn Ferry Tour Finals. Pro-Am Ranking will be based off the points list following the conclusion of the Magnit Championship.
- PRACTICE TEE** is limited to **220 yard maximum distance**. All Drivers and Fairway woods must be hit into the hitting nets on the practice tee, along with any shots with over 220 yards. **Players not abiding by this will lose**

practice tee access for the remainder of the week and be subject to Disciplinary Action in accordance with Korn Ferry Tour Rules & Regulations.

- **PLAYER REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play; Player Registration will be located in the Ladies Locker Room. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **CADDIE REGISTRATION** is located inside the Ladies Locker Room. Hours of operations are listed above.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the Mens Locker Room Lounge.
- **GYM ACCESS** is available on-site in the clubhouse. Available daily from 5:30 AM – 8:00 PM
- **TICKETS** Players can request up to 2 tickets per player for family and friends. Tickets can be picked up in the Tournament Office, located in the parking lot. These tickets will provide access to Concerts, as will Player and Spouse credentials.
- **LOCKER ROOM/CLUB STORAGE** Locker Room is available this week, but players are prohibited from leaving their clubs in the Locker Room overnight. There is no bag storage available this week.
- **PLAYER DINING** is located in the clubhouse in the 19th Hole and is open to players and a spouse/significant other with a TOUR issued credential ONLY. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the clubhouse parking lot. Due to limited parking, it is encouraged for players and caddies to carpool when possible.
- **CADDIE PARKING** is located in LOT D.
- **CADDIE DINING** is located in the Indoor Tennis Courts right of the 18th fairway. See Breakfast & Lunch schedules above.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on Hole #10 must yield to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds already in progress. Abuse of Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use the 2022, 2023 or 2024 Committee Approved Book.

Following a normal winter weather season and cool spring, Hillcrest Country Club is in an optimal position for this year's event. The bentgrass/Poa annua greens are dense and firm and are expected to provide playing conditions similar to previous years. The cool-season blend of grasses on the closely mown areas and rough have good density and coverage and are expected to provide quality playing conditions. Earlier this year, Hillcrest welcomed the new Golf Course Superintendent, Matthew Gourlay.

Quick Facts:

- Greenspeed will be in the 12' range, as weather conditions allow.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.425 inch.
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.450 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.25 inches, and the primary rough will be maintained at 3+ inches.
