NEED TO KNOW

- **REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play; Player & Caddie Registration will be located in the foyer of the clubhouse which is located through the main doors. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the President’s Room in the clubhouse.
- **CLUB STORAGE** will be available. Please coordinate with the golf shop.
- **LOCKER ROOM** facilities will be available. Each player has an assigned locker with nameplate. Details will be provided at Player and Caddie registration.
- **MONDAY PRO-AM** will take place on Monday, June 26th. There will be a 9-hole shotgun start at 9:30 a.m. (back 9 only) and an 18-hole shotgun start at 1:00p.m. (starting on holes 1-9). There will be a field of approximately 13 teams in the morning and 13 teams in the afternoon. Front 9 practice rounds are

allowed before 1p.m., at which point players must be off the course. Back 9 practice rounds are available before 9:30a.m. AND anytime after 5p.m.

- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will take place on Wednesday, June 28th as a 9 & 9 format with starting times from approximately 6:45 to 8:30 am and 12:00 to 2:00 pm. There will be a full field of 52 teams. 9-hole practice rounds will be available up until 6:30 am and must NOT interfere with the Pro-Am. Practice rounds are NOT available following the Official Pro-Am.
- **TICKETS** are complimentary to all spectators (grounds only). [CLICK HERE](#) for spectator parking information on the tournament website.
- **HEALTH SERVICES** will be provided on-site on a walk-up or appointment basis throughout tournament week. The following services will be available: physicals, physical therapy, chiropractic care, behavioral health, sports psychology, haircuts, manicures, massage therapy, bone density screening, dermatology screening, mindfulness groups and pet therapy. - **FITNESS CENTER** will be provided complimentary at two local YMCA locations for all players and caddies. Show your tour-issued credential and introduce yourself to facility staff as a Korn Ferry Tour Player. Players are reminded that there is NOT an on-site gym/fitness facility at Panther Creek Country Club. Please see 'Player and Caddie Handbook' for locations and hours.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the main golf course parking lot. Players must show their Tour-issued Credential to Security & Parking Volunteers.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be located on the Main Level of the clubhouse in the Main Dining Room. Enter through the main entrance to the Club and follow signage to Player/Caddie Dining. Refer to the tournament page on PGATOURLinks.com for player dining menus for Monday - Sunday.
Note: Player dining will be open to players, caddies and one immediate family member with a TOUR issued credential. Family members will be required to eat in the hospitality structure at hole #18 Thursday to Sunday. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be available free of charge at Player and Caddie Registration. Professional players and caddies **MUST** use the 2022 or 2023 Committee Approved Books.
- **CADDIE PARKING** is available on the street in the Panther Creek subdivision. Do NOT block driveways or mailboxes or you risk being towed at your own expense.
- **CADDIE DINING** is complimentary and caddies will be hosted in Player Dining. Same hours of operation as above.

Panther Creek Country Club will host the Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS. Following a mild Midwest winter, the golf course is well-positioned for tournament week. The greens are a 70/30 mix of Pennncross creeping bentgrass and *Poa annua*. Routine topdressing has continued through the spring to help firm and smooth the putting surfaces. Expansive Penneagle bentgrass tees and fairways are in good condition with complete turf coverage. New golf course Superintendent, Brandon Razo has been focused on reducing thatch on tees to improve firmness. The rough at Panther Creek is a mix of tall fescue, Kentucky bluegrass, *Poa annua*, *Poa trivialis*, and bentgrass. The rough is in good condition but has thinned out due to recent weather conditions in the Midwest.

Quick Facts:

The greenspeed will be in the range of 11.5 – 12”

The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.425”

The fairways will be mowed at 0.425”

The intermediate rough will be cut at 1.25” and the primary rough will be maintained at 3.0”
