NEED TO KNOW

- ***REMINDER* KORN FERRY TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP PRO-AM** please note that the Official Pro-Am at the Korn Ferry Tour Championship is on Tuesday, October 3rd. Format is an 18-hole Pro-Am with AM and PM starting times with approximately 50 teams.
- **MONDAY PRO-AM** is an 18-hole shotgun starting at 12:00 p.m. on both the Scarlet & Gray course and will take place on Monday, September 18th. There will be approximately 30 teams (15 on each course) comprised of 1 professional and 4 amateurs. Practice rounds are permitted in advance of the Pro-Am and players must clear the course prior to 12:00 p.m. shotgun.

- **NATIONWIDE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL CHAMPIONSHIP OFFICIAL PRO-AM** is **9&9 format** and will take place on Wednesday, September 20th with starting times from approximately 7:20 a.m. - 9:10 a.m. & 12:20 p.m. – 2:02 p.m. There will be approximately 54 teams comprised of 1 professional and 2 amateurs. Eligibility will be based off the KFT Overall Finals Points List at the conclusion of the Simmons Bank Open for the Snedeker Foundation. Practice rounds will be permitted before the pro-am and must not interfere with the pro-am or agronomy crew. No practice rounds are permitted after the pro-am. Pro-Am outs may not be used in the Korn Ferry Tour Finals.
- **PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie Registration will be in the Scoring Tent located on the right side of the clubhouse (North side) adjacent to the Media Tent.
- **THE OSU GRAY GOLF COURSE & OSU GOLF TEAM'S SHORT GAME AREA** are both **closed** during tournament week and may not be used for any practice or play. The OSU Golf Team's short game area is located to the right of hole #18 fairway.
- **FIRST SHOT TO FIGHT CANCER** a ceremony to kick-off championship week will be conducted on the 1st tee prior to the start of round one which includes the "First Shot to Fight Cancer". Thank you for your support of this special ceremony.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** schedule is outlined above in the Hours of Operation and located in Women's Locker Room on the 3rd floor of the clubhouse.
- **GYM ACCESS** is available for players only at 'The Golf Room' which is located at 6615 Dublin Center Dr, Dublin, OH 43017. You can visit their website for hours and more information at thegolfroom.com. Your PGA TOUR issued credential is required to gain access.
- **GENERAL ADMISSION TICKETS** are available digitally at ncc-golf.com and are free of charge.
- **PLAYER PARKING** is in the clubhouse parking lot at The Ohio State University Golf Club. We encourage players and caddies to carpool throughout the week. Players must show their credential to access the parking lot.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be in the dining room of the clubhouse and will be open to players and one guest (spouse or significant other) with a proper credential issued by Korn Ferry Tour/PGA TOUR (hours listed above). NOTE: All dining on Wednesday will be located in the hospitality structure behind hole #18 green.
- **LOCKER ROOM** facilities and shoe cleaning are available. Each player will have their own locker assigned by name plate. The club and the tournament are **NOT** responsible for items left in the locker room.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is permitted in the locker room overnight this week only. The locker room will be staffed and locked overnight. The club and the tournament are **NOT** responsible for items left in the locker room.
- **CADDIE PARKING** is located at Advent Lutheran Church (3660 Kenny Rd., Columbus, OH. 43220) which is across the street from the golf course and a short walk. A parking pass will be handed out at registration for the remainder of the week.



- **CADDIE DINING** will be in a climate-controlled tent located adjacent to the practice range. A proper tournament specific credential from registration is required for entrance.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be complimentary for each Player and Caddie (limit 1 per person) at Player/Caddie Registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use the 2022 or 2023 Committee Approved Book.

The Scarlet Course is coming out of the summer in exceptionally good condition with no major conditioning concerns. This year’s tournament date moves from August to September. The cooler weather in September is conducive to optimal conditions of cool-season surfaces on the Scarlet Course. The L-93 bentgrass greens are in excellent condition. Tees and fairways are in very good condition at a height of 0.400”. Number 3 tee was leveled and expanded slightly since last year’s tournament.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be 12 - 12.5 feet.
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.400 inch.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.350 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.25 inches, and the primary rough will be 3-4 inches.
