NEED TO KNOW

- PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play. Player Registration will be located in the Members Lounge & Caddie Registration will be located in the Ballroom (Volunteer & Caddie HQ) Hours of operation are listed above. Locker room fee is \$25 and club repair fee is \$15.
- COURTESY VEHICLES will be provided by BMW to the Top 30 players on the KFT Points List as of Monday July 17th. Vehicles may be picked up after Player Registartion is complete. The terms of agreement with BMW limit the use of an Official Vehicle to the player and/or his spouse ONLY. A waiver will be signed at Player Registartion. If you are in the Top 30, but do not wish to use a courtesy vehicle, please notify the staff at Player Registration. NOTE: If player's in the Top 30 are not participating, or decline use of a courtesy vehicle, the next players on the points list will be offered the vehicle.







- PHYSICAL THERAPY is located in the Women's & Men's Locker Rooms on the lower level of the clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above.
- WHOOP representatives will be onsite starting Wednesday and be located near player dining. Devices and subscriptions will be available to everyone competing this week.
- CLUB STORAGE is not available.
- LOCKER ROOM facilities and shoe cleaning are available. Each player will have their own locker assigned
 by name plate, but keys will not be distributed. Neither the club or the tournament are responsible for
 items left in the locker room. Locker Room Attendants hours will be 7:00 am 7:00 pm daily.
- **FITNESS CENTER** is not available at The Glen Club. An alternative option will be available at Player Registration.
- ON-CALL DOCTOR is not available directly through the tournament. First Aid is located on-site all week.
- MONDAY PRO-AM There will be a field of approximately 27 teams for the RSM Pro-Am. Play will be off #1 & #10 from 12:00 pm 2:10 pm. Practice rounds are available off #1 and #10 tees beginning at 7:00 am, no play may begin from the 10th tee after 8:30 am. No play may begin off Hole #1 or #10 after 11:30 am. 1st & 10th tees will be available again at 5:00 pm, play must remain one hole behind the Pro-Am.
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** The Chick Evans Memorial Pro-Am will take place on Wednesday, July 26th as a 9 & 9 format with starting times from approximately 7:00 to 8:50 am and 12:00 to 2:01 pm. There will be a field of approximately 46 teams. 9-hole practice rounds will be available from #1 and #10 tees until 6:45 am and must <u>NOT</u> interfere with the Pro-Am. Practice rounds are <u>NOT</u> permitted after the official pro-am.
- PLAYER PARKING will be located in the main clubhouse parking lot. A TOUR issued Player credential will be required to gain access.
- PLAYER DINING will be located on the main level of the clubhouse, in ther Grill Room, and will be open to
 players and one spouse/significant other (including children) with a TOUR issued credential (hours listed
 above).
- **CADDIE PARKING** is located in Lot B, diretly adjacent to The Glen Club clubhouse. Access to Lot B is at the intersection of Lake Ave and Valor Drive, just east of the clubhouse parking lot. Parking pass will be required and is obtained at Caddie Registration.
- CADDIE DINING will be located on the main level of the clubhouse, in the Ballroom (hours listed above).
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be available free of charge at Player and Caddie Registration. Players and caddies MUST use the 2022 or 2023 Committee Approved Books.
- SHORT GAME AREA at the back of the range, is available for use by players. The tee deck adjacent to the Short Game Area is closed, and not available for use. Any use of this tee will be subject to disciplinary action.







- SHUTTLES TO #10 TEE will be available from the back of the Practice Range, Monday-Friday at the times
 highlighted on the tournament week schedule below. Players should allow ample time to arrive at the 10th
 tee for their starting time. Return shuttles for players concluding play on #9 will be available during
 applicable tournament rounds.

Golf Course Superintendent: Adam Wiles **PGA TOUR Agronomist:** PJ Ringenberger

The Glen Club has experienced very good growing conditions leading up to this event. Although the club hosts both members and public play and has been very busy, Adam Wiles, and his team have done a very good job in providing great turf quality and an overall great product for the event next week. There have been no significant course changes but the date change for this event from May to July will allow for a different look around the property as everything is in top summer form.

- The mostly bentgrass greens are smooth and should provide good firmness while boasting greenspeeds of 11-12'
- The tees and approaches are maintained at .375" Height of cut and fairways are .400"
- The Rough was mowed at 2.25" and will be allowed to grow through the event which will result in 3-4" rough during competition rounds.
