NEED TO KNOW

- PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie
 Registration will be located on the lower level of the clubhouse just outside the Men's Locker Room.
 Hours of operation are listed above. Locker room fee is \$25 and club repair fee is \$15.
- PHYSICAL THERAPY is located in the Locker Room on the lower level of the clubhouse. Hours of operation
 are listed above.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is not available.
- LOCKER ROOM facilities and shoe cleaning are available. Each player will have their own locker assigned
 by name plate, but keys will not be distributed. <u>Neither the club or the tournament</u> are responsible for
 items left in the locker room. Locker Room Attendants hours will be the same as those listed above for
 Physical Therapy.





- **FITNESS CENTER** will be available for player use and is located on the lower level of the clubhouse. Hours of operation will be the same as the practice facilities hours of operation listed above.
- ON-CALL DOCTOR Dr. Chad Smidt may be contacted for non-emegency medical situations at (970) 227-0763 or csmidt@orthohealth.com. First Aid and located on-site all week.
- MONDAY PRO-AM The Pins and Aces Shootout will be an 18-hole shotgun start at 12:30 pm (starting on holes #4-15). There will be a field of approximately 12 teams. Practice rounds are available off #1 and #10 tees beginning at 7:00 am, with the 10th tee closing at 8:30 am. Practice rounds may continue until 12:00 pm, prior to the start of the Pro-Am.
 - The Heron Lakes Junior Pro-Am will be a 6-hole tee time start from 5:00-5:50 pm off #1 tee. There will be a field of approximately 24 teams, playing in 6 groups, using holes #1, 14-18. Practice rounds may commence at approximately 5:00 pm on holes not being utilized by the Junior Pro-Am; players and caddies must yield to the Junior Pro-Am on the holes listed above.
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** The Corona Premier Pro-Am will take place on Wednesday, July 12th as a 9 & 9 format with starting times from approximately 6:30 to 8:20 am and 11:50 to 1:40 pm. There will be a field of approximately 44 teams. 9-hole practice rounds will be available from #1 and #10 tees until 6:15 am and must NOT interfere with the Pro-Am. Practice rounds are **NOT** permitted after the official pro-am.
- PLAYER PARKING will be located in the main clubhouse parking lot. A TOUR issued credential will be
 required to gain access. Note that players will be directed to a gravel path for more efficient access to the
 main lot before the main entryway.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be located on the main level of the clubhouse and will be open to players and one spouse/significant other (including children) with a TOUR issued credential (hours listed above).
- CADDIE PARKING is located in the Water Tower lot on the north-side of the clubhouse parking lot. A caddie
 credential will be required to gain access and will be distributed at registration. Please identify yourself as
 a caddie prior to registering to gain access.
- **CADDIE DINING** will be located in the TPC Colorado Café inside the clubhouse; caddies have access to restroom facilities in the hallway opposte the TPC Colorado Café. Please use the exterior doors on either side of the golf shop for access (hours listed above).
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be available free of charge at Player and Caddie Registration. Professional players and caddies MUST use the 2022 or 2023 Committee Approved Books.
- SHUTTLES TO #10 TEE will be available Monday-Wednesday at the times highlighted on the tournament week schedule below. During tournament rounds, players must be in the shuttle going to #10 tee 20 minutes prior to their starting time. Shuttles will be staged and will only depart from the driveway adjacent to the practice facilities. Return shuttles for players concluding play on #9 will be available during applicable tournament rounds.
- PARKING NEAR #10 TEE does not have any reserved spaces for players or caddies in the new recently
 installed parking lot. Players and caddies are advised that this area will be used for staging various





vehicles: Pro-Am carts, buses and vans for course evacuations and shuttle drop-off/pick-up (as outlined below in the Tournament Week Schedule). Limited spaces may be utilized on a space-available basis Monday-Tuesday, but overflow parking on adjacent neighborhood streets is not permitted and risks ticketing/towing by local law enforcement. As outlined above, parking spaces are not reserved for players or caddies; use during Wednesday Pro-Am and tournament rounds is prohibited.

• TICKETS will be available by scanning the QR Code below, at Player Registration or in the Locker Room. There is a maximum quantity of eight any day tickets per transaction. All tickets are digital.

TPC Colorado has emerged slowly from winter dormancy and will require warmer temperatures and filling-in before it can be well-positioned for the event. The large T-1 bentgrass greens have good coverage and are expected to produce firm conditions with high-quality ball roll characteristics. The blue/ryegrass tees and fairways possess some isolated winter damage that should have no problem recovering over the next few weeks and should also provide firm playing conditions. All closely mown areas will be maintained like in previous years. Course enhancements include a rock wall behind #8 green and a new tee on hole #10.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be 11.0', dependent upon wind.
- The tees and fairways will be mowed at 0.400".
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.0", and the primary rough will be maintained at 3.0".
