NEED TO KNOW

- PACE OF PLAY POLICY CHANGES** For the remainder of the 2025 season, the following pace of play policy will be in effect. When being timed, a player will no longer receive a warning for their first "bad time". Bad times will be treated as follows: first bad time – one penalty stroke, second bad time – additional two stroke penalty, third bad time – disqualification. Bad times will carry over to subsequent rounds during the tournament. For any requests regarding this pace-of-play policy, please seek an on-site member of the Rules Committee. **PLEASE NOTE**, for the BMW Charity Pro-Am presented by TD SYNEX, only timings during Round Four will count towards a player's cumulative total for the season.
- REGISTRATION** will be available **ONLY** at Thornblade Club. The Korn Ferry Tour Registration policy is amended for this tournament to allow players to play practice rounds at Carolina Country Club prior to registering at Thornblade Club. Player/Caddie Registration will be located in the Haas Grille adjacent to the Men's Locker Room at Thornblade Club. Hours of operation are listed above. Yardage books for Thornblade Club will be available to both players and caddies at Player/Caddie Registration.

- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **TEE TIMES FOR PRACTICE ROUNDS** will **NOT** be required for professionals. Amateurs are still asked to make a tee time so please be accommodating on the tees.
- **GOLF CARTS - REMINDER** that golf carts will **NOT** be available to professionals or professional caddies for practice rounds.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the private dining room adjacent to Player Dining inside the main doors of the clubhouse at Thornblade Club ONLY.
- **THE PRO-TRANS PRO-AM** will take place on Monday, June 2nd at Thornblade Club and will be a 12:00 p.m. Shotgun. All practice rounds **MUST** be completed prior to 11:45 a.m. If you are interested in playing please reach out to Brad McGahey 904-495-5785.
- **THE PRESIDENT'S PRO-AM presented by MAU** will take place on Tuesday, June 3rd at Carolina Country Club and will be a double shotgun at 8:00 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. **THERE WILL BE NO PRACTICE ROUND AVAILABILITY AT CAROLINA COUNTRY CLUB ON JUNE 3RD FOR PROFESSIONALS NOT PLAYING IN PRO-AM.**
- **PLAYER TICKET REQUESTS** should be made directly to Contestant Services located in the main entrance of the clubhouse at Thornblade Club.
- **FITNESS FACILITY ACCESS** is available to players on-site at Carolina Country Club. The Fitness Center at Carolina Country Club is located on the far (east) side of the main parking lot. Facilities will be available during the same hours as the practice facilities are available. Tour credential will be required for access. There is no Fitness Center at Thornblade Club. Both players and caddies will have access to Powerhouse Gym (1018 S. Batesville Road, Greer, SC 29650). Hours are Monday – Friday 5:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m., Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and Sunday 2:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. PGA TOUR or Tournament credentials are required for access.
- **BMW PERFORMANCE DRIVING SCHOOL** will be available to all players and caddies on Tuesday, June 3rd starting at 4 p.m. Please use this link to sign-up prior to arrival.

- **PLAYER DINING** at Thornblade Club is located on the main level of the clubhouse in the main dining room. Player Dining at Carolina Country Club will be located inside the clubhouse. Please refer to the tournament page on PGATOURLinks.com for player dining menu's during the week. Player dining will only be open to players, people with a "3" on a TOUR issued credential and player's children aged 5 and under (please note hours of operation listed above). Family members without a Tour issued credential will be able to purchase food upstairs at Thornblade Club only Thursday – Sunday.
- **PLAYER PARKING** at both golf courses will be located in the clubhouse lot. Parking is limited and parking passes for Thornblade Club will be distributed at Player Registration (one per player). Please show your TOUR credential for access to the clubhouse lot at Carolina Country Club.

****The Thornblade Club clubhouse lot specific parking pass must be displayed at all times. If a player loses the parking pass, they will not be allowed to park in the clubhouse parking lot and will need to access the**

tournament via the off-site parking lot at Michellin. If a player fails to display the parking pass at all times when parked in the lot, they are subject to the car potentially being towed.

Please note to gain access to the clubhouse lot at Thornblade you **MUST** access Thornblade Blvd. via Meiland Dr. The entrance off The Parkway will be closed during tournament week.



- **YARDAGE BOOKS** for Thornblade Club will be available free of charge at Player Registration. Yardage books for Carolina Country Club will **ONLY** be available on-site at Carolina CC on the Golf Shop veranda, also free of charge. Professional players and caddies **MUST** use the 2022-2025 Committee Approved Books.
- **LOCKER ROOM** will be provided to each player in the field while at Thornblade Club. The Men's Locker Room at Thornblade Club is located down the hallway to your right upon entering the main clubhouse doors and the entrance will be on your left. Please note that at Carolina Country Club the Men's Locker Room will have limited access.
- **EQUIPMENT DISTRIBUTION** will be in the Men's Locker Room at Thornblade Club.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is not available.
- **CADDIE PARKING** for Thornblade Club will be located at Covenant United Methodist Church (1310 Old Spartanburg Rd., Greer, SC 29650) Monday-Friday and shuttles will be provided to the golf course. Shuttle dropoff will again be located next to the Volunteer/Caddie Area by the Practice Area. Saturday and Sunday Caddie Parking is located in the lower lot at Michelin Headquarters (1 Parkway S., Greenville, SC 29615). **PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN THE WAL-MART PARKING LOT AND TRY TO WALK IN AS YOU WILL BE STOPPED AND DENIED ACCESS.** Caddie parking at Carolina Country Club is located in the grass lot through the main entrance gate on your left before arriving at the clubhouse; carpooling is encouraged to maximize use of the space.
- **CADDIE DINING** at Thornblade Club is located in the Volunteer Area next to the pool behind the range. Hot breakfast items will be available beginning at 5:30 a.m. Monday-Sunday. At Carolina Country Club Caddie Dining will be available in the Volunteer Area adjacent to the pool.

BMW Charity Pro-Am presented by TD SYNEX Agronomy Report**Thornblade Club (Host Course)**

The golf course at Thornblade Club emerged from a cool and wet winter in relatively good condition and is entering a period where active bermudagrass growth should soon resume. The A1/A4 creeping bentgrass putting greens have recovered from an earlier core aeration and are nicely positioned to provide smooth, firm surfaces. Given the late spring date and nature of the event, contestants should not anticipate a penal rough. Several changes have been made to the golf course since last year's event. These include the repositioning of the tee and subsequent lengthening of Hole #5 by 25+ yards, the extension of the tee at Hole #9 by 22 yards, and the expansion of fairway mowing contours to include the grass bunker edges along the fairway and green side of the hole. Additionally, the creek bank located between Holes #5 and #8 was partially restored this past summer.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be in the 13 feet range.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.325 inch.
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.375 inch.
- The primary rough will be maintained at 1¾ inches.

Carolina Country Club

Golf Course Superintendent: Gary Wilder

The golf course at Carolina Club experienced a significant flood event in January that covered many of the back nine fairways in various depths of silt, and over 20 sand bunkers were severely damaged. Subsequent removal of the silt was slowed by continued wet weather and a lack of personnel. The result is a subset of fairways and approaches in very poor condition. Recently hired Golf Course Superintendent, Gary Wilder is now attempting to finish removing the excess silt in remaining areas, while aggressively fertilizing these holes over the following weeks in hopes that at least marginally acceptable conditions can be present for the event. Specifically, the fairways and holes #10, #13, #14, #15, and #16 are of the greatest concern. The damaged bunkers have all been repaired and new sand installed where required. The Champion bermudagrass putting greens survived the winter relatively unblemished and should provide smooth, fast conditions again this year.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be in the 12-foot range.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.400 inch.
- The fairways will be mowed between 0.450 and 0.500 inch, depending on turfgrass recovery.

- The primary rough will be maintained between 1¾ - 2 inches.
