- MANDATORY PLAYING MEETING**

- Date: Tuesday, April 1, 2025
- Start Time: 5:00 pm
- Location: Palmetto Clubhouse, The Landings Golf & Athletic Club (1 Cottonwood Dr., Savannah, GA 31411)



- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** is **18-holes** and will take place on Wednesday, April 2nd with 8:00 am and 1:45 pm shotgun starts. There will be approximately 54 teams. Players are allowed to walk the golf course and putt and chip prior to the first starting time, but the golf course must be clear by the 8:00 am shotgun start. Practice rounds will not be available following the pro-am.
- **AVERAGE STROKE TIME (AST)** will be recorded starting this week. At the conclusion of a tournament a player's average stroke time (AST) is compared against the field average. For a given tournament, if a player has an average stroke time of 7.0 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an average stroke time (AST) infraction. For a given tournament, if a player has an average stroke time of 12.0 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an EXCESSIVE average stroke time (AST). Players who receive an AST or Excessive AST will be notified via email on Monday or Tuesday following the tournament by the Competitions Department via email with additional details regarding the infraction. AST infractions are accumulated during the season before monetary fines are applied. The player can track their progress via the Player Links App. Instructional information to find their AST on the Links app can be found in the Bluesheet. If you have questions, please find a rules official or ask questions while the Pace of Play Policy is being covered in the Player Meeting.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the Golf Performance Center on the front of the range.
- **TICKETS** can be obtained by clicking the website link below. Only General Admission tickets can be obtained complimentary by entering the code KFT. https://www.cuetoems.com/clubcar_2025/Tickets.aspx
- **PLAYER REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play; Player Registration will be located inside the the Deer Creek clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is not available.
- **LOCKER ROOM** facilities are not available.
- **EQUIPMENT DISTRIBUTION** will be at the equipment trailers on the south end of the driving range.
- **PLAYER DINING** is located in the Deer Creek clubhouse, open to players and spouse/significant other with a TOUR issued credential. Additional player dining access for other family members will be available for purchase, please see registration for complete details. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the Lot 1 clubhouse. Parking passes will be issued at Player Registration.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use the 2023, 2024 or 2025 Committee Approved Book.
- **CADDIE PARKING** will be located in Lot 2. Parking passes will be issued at Caddie Registration.
- **CADDIE REGISTRATION** is located in the caddie tent on the driving range.
- **CADDIE DINING** is located in the Golf Performance Center next to the driving range. Hours of operation are 6:00 am to 10:30 am for breakfast and 11:00 am to 3:00 pm for lunch Monday-Sunday. At registration caddies will receive a tournament issued credential that must be shown at caddie dining. The credential will be used as a



punch card system for breakfast and lunch each day. This credential is **REQUIRED** to receive access to caddie dining.
