NEED TO KNOW

- AVERAGE STROKE TIME (AST)** is being recorded each week. At the conclusion of a tournament, a player's stroke time (AST) is compared against the field average. For a given tournament, if a player has an average stroke time of 7.0 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an average stroke time (AST) infraction and will be notified via email on Monday or Tuesday following the tournament by the Competitions Department via email with additional details regarding the infraction. AST infractions are accumulated during the season before monetary fines are applied. Players can track their progress via the Player Links App. Instructional information to find their AST on the Links app can be found in the Bluesheet.
- REGISTRATION** Must be completed before practice or play. Player Registration will be located in the Event Center (player dining) and Caddie Registration will be located in the clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed

above. Yardage books will be available to both players and caddies at Registration.

- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the Cawley Center adjacent to the practice range tee. Hours of operation are listed above. Please use the door on the driving range side to avoid walking through the media center.
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will take place on Wednesday, June 19th as a 9 & 9 scramble format with starting times off #1 and #10 from 7:30 a.m. – 8:40 a.m. and 11:40 a.m. – 12:40 p.m. with approximately 30 teams. Course available for 9 hole practice rounds prior to the pro-am. Practice on the course will be allowed after the pro-am for 9 holes only from 3 p.m. – 5 p.m..
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **PLAYER TICKET REQUESTS** should be made directly to Player Services located in Player Dining.
- **PRODUCT DISTRIBUTION** will be in Player Dining.
- **FITNESS FACILITY ACCESS** is available at the Norman Regional Health Club (2301 36th Avenue, Norman, OK 73072). Norman Regional Health Club will be open from 5 a.m. – 10 p.m. on Monday-Friday; 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Saturday; and 1 p.m. – 5 p.m. on Sunday. Players must have their TOUR issued credential to gain access.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be located in the “Event Center” adjacent to the clubhouse. Player dining will be open only to players and one spouse/significant other with a TOUR issued credential. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the clubhouse parking lot. A parking pass will be available at registration and is required for access.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be available free of charge at Player and Caddie Registration. Professional players and caddies **MUST** use the 2023 or 2024 Committee Approved Books.
- **LOCKER ROOM** will not have access to lockers.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is not available.
- **CADDIE PARKING** will be located in Lot C, which is the grass lot across E. Constitution St. A parking pass will be available at registration and is required to access. Shuttles will be provided to the clubhouse.

AGRONOMY

The Jimmie Ausitn OU Golf Club is well positioned to host the second playing of the Compliance Solutions Championship. The creeping bentgrass/Poa annua cool-season greens are in good agronomic condition and will be smooth and true. All other surfaces are comprised of warm-season zoysia or bermudagrass. The zoysia tees, collars, and approaches are tightly cropped when mowed at 0.225'. In select areas, mainly between bunkers and greens where sand splash was present, the zoysiagrass collars were negatively affected by cold temperature and will require spot sodding that may leave some visibly evident sod seams during th event. The bermudagrass fairways are in good condition. The fairways were narrowed by approximately 5 feet on each side allowing ofr an intermediate cut of rough along fairway edges.

Quick Facts:

- The greenspeed will be in the range of 11.5 - 12.0'.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.225 inch.
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.400 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 0.750 inch, and the primary rough will be topped off toward the end of advance week 2.50 inches.
