NEED TO KNOW

AVERAGE STROKE TIME (AST) is being recorded each week. At the conclusion of a tournament a player's average stroke time (AST) is compared against the field average. For a given tournament, if a player has an average stroke time of 7.0 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an average stroke time (AST) infraction and will be notified via email on Monday or Tuesday following the tournament by the Competitions Department via email with additional details regarding the infraction. AST infractions are accumulated during the season before monetary fines are applied. Players can track their progress via the Player Links App. Instructional information to find their AST on the Links app can be found in the Bluesheet.





- MONDAY PRO-AM (THE COX GROUP PRO-AM) will be an 18-hole pro-am with tee times from approximately 10:00 a.m. 12:12 p.m. Practice rounds are permitted from approximately 7:30 a.m. off #1 and #10 tees with both tees closing at 9:45 a.m. #10 tee will re-open for practice rounds at approximately 3:45 p.m. #1 tee will remain closed due to the Smithville Varsity Shootout beginning at 4:00 p.m.
- OFFICIAL PRO-AM (OLD NATIONAL BANK PRO-AM) will be an 18-hole pro-am on both Tuesday, October 1st and Wednesday, October 2nd with the field divided by priority ranking. Players ranked 1-11 and 23-33 on the official points list will play on Tuesday from approximately 12:00 p.m. 2:12 p.m. Players ranked 12-22 and 34-44 will play from approximately 8:30 a.m. 10:42 a.m. on Wednesday. There will be 4 sponsor picks for each day. Please plan travel accordingly. As a reminder, per KFT Regs, Pro-Am 'Outs' may not be used during the Korn Ferry Tour Finals Events. For practice round information on Tuesday and Wednesday please see the Tournament Week Schedule below.
- PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play. Registration will be located in the Erwin Room (G) on the lower level of the Meeting & Event Center at French Lick Resort. Please see attached map. For players and caddies not staying on-site at French Lick Resort, please park in the Parking Garage
- **PLAYER HEADSHOTS** will be available in the Erwin Room (G) during Player Registration hours Monday-Wednesday.
- PHYSICAL THERAPY will be located in the Dickason Room (H) on the lower level of the Meeting & Event Center at French Lick Resort. Please see attached map. Parking available in the Parking Garage.
- **PLAYER TICKET REQUESTS** will be available at player registration. There is a maximum quantity of four Weekly General Admission tickets per player.
- PLAYER PARKING at The Pete Dye Course will be located in Lot B via Gate 3. Please show your TOURissued credential for access.
- **CADDIE PARKING** at the Pete Dye Course will be located in Lot A via Gate 1 and shuttle carts will be provided to the Pavilion/Driving Range. Please show your tournament Caddie credential for access.
- PLAYER/CADDIE DINING BREAKFAST will be located in the Grand Colonnade Restaurant (E) at French Lick
 Resort. Players and caddies will receive daily vouchers for breakfast at Registration. Players will also
 receive an additional voucher for their spouse/significant other, provided they have a TOUR-issued
 credential. Players, spouses/significant others and caddies <u>MUST</u> show their credential along with the
 voucher to gain access to the Grand Colonnade Restaurant for breakfast. Hours of operation listed above.
- PLAYER/CADDIE DINING LUNCH will be located in the Taggart Mansion at The Pete Dye Course at French Lick Resort. Players may bring a spouse/significant other with a Tour-issued credential. Hours listed above.
- LOCKER ROOM/CLUB STORAGE there are no locker room facilities and club storage is not available. All
 player products will be available for pick up at the Equipment Trucks immediately behind the Practice
 Range tee deck.





- **FITNESS CENTER** is located on the Main Level of French Lick Resort (C on the attached Map). Players not staying on-site at French Lick Resort can access the Fitness Center by visiting the Front Desk and obtaining an access card after showing TOUR-issued credential.
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be available free of charge at Player and Caddie Registration. Players and caddies must use a 2024 committee approved book.
- **EQUIPMENT TRUCKS** are located immediately behind the Practice Range tee deck at The Pete Dye Course at French Lick Resort.
- FRENCH LICK RESORT TROLLEY SHUTTLE will run Monday-Wednesday for resort guests to The Pete Dye
 Course leaving from the roundabout in front of the hotel. Thursday-Sunday, guests will take the trolley
 from the front of French Lick Resort to the "Blue Lot" by the Casino to board buses to The Pete Dye
 Course.

The Pete Dye Course at French Lick Resort opened for play in April 2009 and boasts bentgrass greens, tees, and fairways with mostly bluegrass rough. It is situated at the top of a hill and has very few trees which allows for constant breezes and improved summer plant health. The golf course is in exceptional shape. The A1/A4 bentgrass greens are in good condition. All tees, fairways, and approaches also are in great shape. Given course design and elevated summer play levels, divots will be more prevalent in collection areas. Staff will work diligently to minimize the impact ahead of the championship. Rough is very consistent and is expected to provide good lies throughout. The 108 bunkers of varying shapes and sizes are in good shape and drain well. There are a few waste bunkers that will be marked accordingly.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be in the range of 11.5 to 12 feet.
- The fairways will be mowed daily at 0.375 inch.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.275 inch.
- There is no intermediate rough, and the primary rough will be maintained at 2 inches during advance week.
