NEED TO KNOW

- **MONDAY JR PRO-AM** will be a SHOTGUN start at 2:00 PM. There will be approximately 20 teams. Practice rounds will be available prior to the pro-am. **ALL practice rounds must be clear of the course by 1:45 PM.**
- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will be on WEDNESDAY in two waves off #1 & #10 from approximately 7:15 AM – 9:30 AM / 12:45 PM – 3:00 PM. (52 teams / 4 amateurs / 9&9 format).
- **SHUTTLES** will be available from the practice facilities to the 1st and 10th tee each day. Additionally, there will be a shuttle from hole #9 to scoring for players finishing their rounds on the 9th hole. During the round, motorized transportation is permitted between the play of Holes #7 and #8.



- **PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play; Player & Caddie Registration will be located in main foyer of the clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **CLUB STORAGE** will be available in the golf shop. Please see a member of the golf shop staff for assistance.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the Locker Room. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PLAYER DINING** is located in the clubhouse and is open to players and a spouse/significant other with a TOUR issued credential ONLY. Hours of operation are listed above. On Sunday 4/5, player AND caddie dining will move to Aerobics Room A in the Amenities Center building.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the Pro Shop Lot. You will need your TOUR issued credential to access the parking lot.
- **CADDIE DINING** is located in the Clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above. On Sunday 4/5, player AND caddie dining will move to Aerobics Room A in the Amenities Center building.
- **CADDIE PARKING** will be located behind Piper Hole #1. Caddie credentials will be issued at registration and needed to access the caddie lot. There will be a shuttle to the clubhouse Monday-Sunday from the caddie lot. Hours of operation will mimic the practice facilities hours listed above.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use Committee approved yardage books since January 1, 2022.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **FREE DENTAL SCREENINGS** Monday through Friday of tournament week (3/30 – 4/3). LECOM School of Dental Medicine is offering free screenings, x-rays and cleaning for all players and their caddies. To make an appointment, please call (941) 405-1606.
- **GYM AND POOL** facilities are available during tournament week. Use of the gym is restricted to players only. However, the pool is available for players and their families. Use of both facilities will be shared with the membership. Gym hours are 6 a.m. – 8 p.m. daily. Pool hours are 10 a.m. – 6 p.m. daily. For access, please see Player Relations.
- **HEADSHOTS FOR PLAYERS** will be available Monday morning through early afternoon on Wednesday in the clubhouse. Please make sure to have updated apparel and sponsor logos if you are in need of a new headshot.
- **TICKETS** are available for players and caddies. There will be a QR code at registration. This will be good for grounds/general admission tickets only.

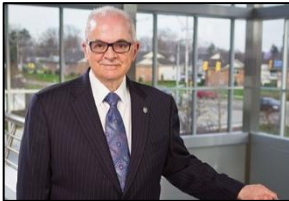

The Commander Course at Lakewood National Golf Club is well positioned for the LECOM Suncoast Classic. The TifEagle bermudagrass greens have full canopies and will provide smooth and firm putting surfaces for the competition. The Celebration bermudagrass tees are in good condition overall. The Celebration bermudagrass fairways are healthy, although moderately divoted due to the high amount of play during the winter months. The Commander Course has benign primary rough that will be maintained at 2 inches. The non-irrigated secondary rough is bahiagrass that will be in the 3-5 inch height range.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be 12.5 to 13.0 feet.
- The tees and fairways will be mowed at .305"
- The approaches will be mowed at .215"
- There is no intermediate cut, and the primary rough will be maintained at 2"
