NEED TO KNOW

• PACE OF PLAY POLICY CHANGES For the remainder of the 2025 season, the following pace of play policy be in effect. When being timed, a player will no longer receive a warning for their first "bad time." Bad times will be treated as follows: first bad time – one penalty stroke, second bad time – additional two stroke penalty, third bad time – disqualification. Bad times will carry over to subsequent rounds during the tournament. Please see a Rules Official onsite if you have any questions.

- **PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play; registration will be located in the Pro Shop. Hours of operation are listed above. Yardage books will be available to both players and caddies at Registration.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the President's Room in the clubhouse.
- PLAYER & CADDIE DINING will be located on the Main Level of the clubhouse in the Main Dining Room. Enter through the main entrance to the Club and follow signage to Player/Caddie Dining. Refer to the tournament page on PGATOUR Link for player dining menus for Monday Sunday.

Note: Player dining will be open to players, caddies and one immediate family member with a TOUR issued credential. Family members are welcome in the Memorial Health Champions Club hospitality structure at hole #18 Thursday to Sunday. Hours of operation are listed above.

- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the main golf course parking lot. Players must be in the car and show their Tour-issued Credential to Security & Parking Volunteers.
- **CADDIE PARKING** is available on the street in the Panther Creek subdivision. Do <u>NOT</u> block driveways or mailboxes or you risk being towed at your own expense. Caddies will be issued a parking placard at registration to place on the dashboard.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use Committee approved yardage books since January 1, 2022.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- MONDAY PRO-AM will take place on Monday, June 23rd. There will be a 9-hole shotgun start at 9:30 am (back 9 only) and an 18-hole shotgun start at 1:00 pm (starting on holes 1-9). There will be a field of 14 teams in the morning and 14 teams in the afternoon. Front 9 practice rounds are allowed before 1:00 pm, at which point players must be off the course. Back 9 practice rounds are available before 9:30 am and anytime after 5:00 pm.
- OFFICIAL PRO-AM will take place on Wednesday, June 25th as a 9 & 9 format with starting times from 6:45 am to 8:57 am and 12:15 pm to 2:27 pm. There will be a full field of 52 teams. Course available for 9-hole practice rounds prior the Pro-Am. Practice rounds are NOT available following the Official Pro-Am.
- **PRO AM TEAM PHOTO** there will be photographers on 1 & 10 to take group photos as each group makes the turn. The front 9 professional needs to walk with their team to the 10th tee (whether that is 1 or 10) to take the full team photo with both professionals. Then both professionals will autograph the frames.
- HEALTH SERVICES will be provided on-site on a walk-up or appointment basis throughout tournament week. The following services will be available: physicals, chiropractic care, first aid, physician consultation, haircuts and dermatology screening. AGRONOMY

The Hale Irwin-designed Panther Creek Country Club is in good condition as it prepares to host the 10th Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS. The greens are a mix of Penncross creeping bentgrass and *Poa annua*. As soil temperatures rise throughout June, the colors of these two grass species will meld together nicely, and we should have true and smooth surfaces for the competition. The Penneagle tees and fairways are also in good condition. Since last year's tournament, the second phase of a fairway reduction project was completed on the front nine as the club converted an additional 3.5 acres of fairways into newly established tall fescue rough. The rough throughout the course is healthy and will provide interest for the competition if Midwest rains linger into mid-June. A new professional tee on #14 was recently resodded and should be ready for this year's tournament.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be 12.5 feet.
- The tees, fairways, and approaches will be mowed at 0.400 inch.
- The intermediate rough will be mowed at 1.5 inches, and the primary rough will be maintained at 3.5 inches.
