NEED TO KNOW

- The **OFFICIAL SIMMONS BANK OPEN PRO-AM PRESENTED BY LOCAL IQ** will take place on Wednesday, September 10th using a 9 & 9 format with starting times from approximately 6:40 AM to 8:35 AM and 11:50 AM to 1:45 PM with approximately 47 teams. Practice rounds are unavailable on Wednesday. However, players can practice chipping and putting on the course ahead of the first pro-am group. Per Korn Ferry Tour Rules & Regulations, Pro-Am outs may not be used in the Korn Ferry Tour Finals.

- There will be a **SIMMONS BANK OUTING** involving 6 groups on Monday, September 8. It will be a 2 p.m. shotgun starting on hole #'s 1-4. Practice rounds are available all day working around this outing.
- The **CLUBHOUSE** renovation at Vanderbilt Legends Club has been completed! Players will enjoy a brand new clubhouse and full use of the locker room and fitness facilities.
- **REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie Registration will be located in the foyer of the front entrance to the clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **COURSE SETUP** – The following adjustments will be made to the layout of the course:
 - **Hole #7** will be played as a par 4 with a maximum yardage of 508 yards (normal back tee).
 - **Hole #17** will utilize the 7th tee of the Little Course which will make the hole play approximately 30 yards longer. On the official scorecard, the yardage for this hole will be listed at 395 yards.
 - **Hole #18** will be played as a par 4 with a maximum yardage of 504 yards. The back tee (527) will not be used.
- **EVENT TICKETS** – The Simmons Bank Open is free General Admission courtesy of Visit Franklin. Tickets are not required for entry, but encouraged. Share this link with anyone interested in attending: <https://oveit.com/hub/event/simmons-bank-open-e7VaQNn4/buy-tickets>
- A **LOCKER ROOM** will be available but players are prohibited from leaving their clubs in the Locker Room overnight. The Locker Room is located on the lower level of the clubhouse. **There will not be bag storage available this week.**
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** will be available upstairs in the clubhouse in the yoga room (adjacent to the gym).
- **GYM ACCESS** will be available upstairs in the clubhouse from 5:00 AM – 3:00 PM
- The **SHORT GAME AREA** to the left of the practice range is for the exclusive use of the Vanderbilt Men's and Women's golf teams and will be unavailable to Korn Ferry Tour players. The 7th green complex of the Little Course (located 50 yards from the 18th green of the North Course) will be used as a short game practice area during this event.
- Any **PLAYER PACKAGES/MAIL** not already placed in a locker will be stored in a room on the north end of The Pavilion - a building that is located near the range. See Zac Smith (615/483-2462) at registration for access.
- The **FAR END OF THE RANGE** will not be available to Korn Ferry Tour players.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the club's main parking lot. Parking passes will be required for access and will be distributed at registration. Beginning Wednesday, player credentials will not grant access to the lot.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be located on the lower level of the clubhouse and is open to players and their spouse/significant other and their children with TOUR-issued credentials. Hours of operation are listed above.

- **CADDIE PARKING** will be located in the club’s main parking lot. Parking passes will be required for access and will be distributed at registration. Beginning Wednesday, caddie credentials will NOT grant access to the lot.
- **CADDIE DINING** is complimentary and will be located in The Pavilion – a building located near the practice range tee. This space will be shared with volunteers. In order to gain access, caddies must show their caddie credentials which will be issued at registration.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use the 2024 or 2025 Committee Approved book.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.





AGRONOMY

The North Course at Vanderbilt Legends Club is in good condition and is well positioned for the upcoming tournament following the recent completion of summer cultural practices. The MiniVerde bermudagrass greens are in good shape, and the Meyer zoysiagrass tees are densely covered. The mix of bermudagrass and zoysiagrass on the fairways and approaches is in overall good condition, and although a few small spots of sod repair from winter damage around the course will likely be visible, they should be fully established by tournament time. A pattern of frequent rainfall this summer has the mix of warm and cool-season grasses in the rough possessing good density. A narrow band of intermediate rough will be installed and maintained near 1.75 inch. Approximately 12 trees have been removed around the course to improve sunlight for turfgrass health. No other changes have been made to the course since last year's event.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be in the range of 12 - 12.5 feet.
- The tees will be mowed at 0.300 inch.
- The approaches will be mowed at 0.375 inch.
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.450 inch.
- Intermediate rough will be mowed near 1.75 inches, and the primary rough will be maintained near 3 inches.
