NOTE: 3rd and 4th Round dining (breakfast and lunch) and practice facility hours of operation are subject to change based on starting times. Opening hours are generally 1.5 hours prior to the first starting time, where possible.

NEED TO KNOW

- VIRTUAL LOCKER ROOM/LOCKER ROOM POSTING BOARDS Each week the Rules Committee will prepare
 documents, notices and policies in these areas for your review. Posted documents will include tournamentspecific information as well as Groupings, Pace of Play, Weather, etc. The Virtual Locker Room is accessible via
 PGA TOUR Links Platforms (Website or Mobile App). Posting Boards will be located in a high-traffic area (i.e.,
 Player Dining) when Locker Rooms are not available or accessible at host facilities.
- COURSE ROUTING / SCORECARD The tournament course routing is adjusted from the club's current course routing by switching the first eight holes on the front/back 9. As such, the club's holes #1-8 will play as #10-17 and #10-17 will play as #1-8. Holes #9 and 18 will maintain their current order in the adjusted routing.

The scorecard below outlines the holes, par and yardage in the correct routing/sequencing for the tournament.

- PLAYER & CADDIE REGISTRATION must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie Registration will
 be in the office adjacent to Player Dining. This room is accessible from the Breezeway dividing the
 Clubhouse/Locker Rooms/Golf Shop. This space will also be designated for each competitive round as the
 Official Scoring Area.
- PLAYER MEETINGS/TOUR STAFF OFFICE HOURS will be held at specific times on Friday and Saturday of
 tournament week, as outlined below, in the Hospitality Structure at the 18th green. The purpose of these
 meetings is to provide an update to players by Player Relations, Rules and Competitions Staff Members to
 discuss player expectations, changes to the Rules of Golf and Pace of Play Policies, as well as eligibility and other
 membership matters. This smaller and non-traditional meeting environment is also intended to facilitate
 engaging discussions for all members, regardless of status or experience.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** As a reminder, and per changes instituted during the 2024 season, prohibitions to practice rounds beginning on #10 tee after a specific time, do not apply during weeks when a 9&9 Pro-Am format is being utilized. However, practice rounds beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Further, players and caddies MUST take into consideration other closures affecting practice rounds, such as the Unofficial Pro-Am played on Thursday.

The Ocean Club has generously offered to accommodate players for practice prior to Thursday, January 9th, subject to club availability, approval and applicable fees. Players may access practice facilities on Wednesday, January 8th, as outlined above, but must contact Robbie Leming in advance for additional access to the practice facility and/or golf course.

• **PRACTICE FACILITIES** Players must take into consideration the length of the driving range (approximately 280 yards) and use discretion when using facilities. Players are responsible for keeping balls within the confines of the range and the respect/safety of their peers. The practice range is bordered by holes #4, 5 & 10 on either side, as well as the short-game area. **Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in the prohibition of specific clubs being used, the revocation of practice facility privileges and/or further disciplinary action.**

The back/far end of the practice range is **NOT** available for use and is **CLOSED** during tournament week. Light towers will be utilized each morning to facilitate agronomic, operations and player preparations, but lights will not be utilized after sunset. Hours of operation are listed above for reference. Please refer to the separate Practice Areas Notice for other scheduled closures for Pro-Ams, Clinics or other special events/maintenance.

- SHUTTLE SERVICES AIRPORT/ATLANTIS Shuttle times are listed below from the Airport to the Atlantis Hotel.

 - If the shuttle times do not coincide with your arrival time, Taxis are available for hire. It is recommended to agree on the transportation fare before leaving for your destination.





• SHUTTLE SERVICES – GOLF COURSE/ATLANTIS A tournament-provided shuttle service will run to/from Atlantis' Royal Tower, Atlantis' Coral Tower and the Ocean Club Golf Course daily. Shuttle services (multiple buses) will run on a consistent basis as outlined during the Hours of Operation above. Shuttles will commence approximately 15-minutes prior to the opening of facilities and conclude following play each day. Updates to the transportation schedule will be sent by text message and email. Transportation is a courtesy; it is the players responsibility to arrive in time for his assigned starting time.

- **THURSDAY PRO-AM** will be a limited number of teams playing in starting times from #1 tee. The first tee will be closed from approximately 8:30 10:00 am on Thursday, January 9th. Practice rounds will be available before and after this Unofficial Pro-Am, but must not interfere with the Pro-Am. Players seeking to play practice rounds starting on the 10th tee **MUST** yield to the Pro-Am when it turns from the front 9 (approximately 11:30 am 1:00 pm). Consult with a member of the Rules Committee with any questions.
- **OFFICIAL (SATURDAY) PRO-AM** is a <u>9&9</u> format and will take place on Saturday, January 11th with starting times from approximately 8:30 10:30 am from the 1st and 10th tees. There will be approximately 24 teams (Teams will be comprised of 4 amateurs and 1 professional). Practice rounds are available off the 1st and 10th tees prior to start of the Official Pro-Am. Players starting on either tee will only be permitted to play 9 holes. Play from either tee <u>MUST NOT</u> interfere with the Official Pro-Am. Official Pro-Am starting times and assignments will be posted on-site (Registration) and online (PGA TOUR Links) on Thursday, January 9th.

Professionals playing the 'first' 9 holes are asked/reminded to hand-off the scorecard to the 'second' 9 professional on the 1^{st} or 10^{th} tee when making the turn and to help facilitate introductions, take a photo, etc. with their amateur grouping.

- **GROUPINGS & STARTING TIMES** will be made available on-site and distributed/posted electronically mid-day on **Friday, January 10**th.
- TICKETS Physical tickets will be available in the form of wristbands and available in the Tournament Office.
- PLAYER PARKING/CADDIE PARKING is very limited and will be located on Ocean Club Drive. Parking passes are
 required, but players/caddies must also be prepared to provide their 2025 Season Credential at the Guard House.
 Players/caddies wishing to obtain a Parking Pass must contact Lauren Pratt (lauren@bdglobalsports.com) in
 advance of their arrival. Parking passes will be issued at Player Registration, if requested in advance. The use of the
 Resort and Tournament Shuttles or carpooling are encouraged. See above for additional information pertaining to
 Shuttle Services.

NOTE: Players renting vehicles MUST pay the Atlantis/Sir Sidney Poitier Bridge Toll in cash (\$2 BSD/USD).





- PLAYER DINING is located in the Clubhouse Restaurant, open to players and credentialed spouses. Players and spouses <u>MUST</u> be prepared to show their credentials for access. Hours of operation are listed above and subject to change.
- CADDIE DINING is complimentary and located in the Caddie Hospitality Tent situated between Ocean Club Drive and #10 fairway. Caddies <u>MUST</u> obtain a Caddie Credential at Registration to access dining. Hours of operation are listed above. Do not access these facilities by crossing the 10th fairway during play.
- LOCKER ROOM facilities are located in a separate building near the Golf Shop. Players will not have access to lockers, but may utilize restroom facilities in this area. Secure storage is in the Cart Garage below the Locker Room, players will have an assigned area to store items securely throughout the week. Please note that personal items may not be left in the Locker Room or Player Dining Areas unattended.
- **CLUB STORAGE** is secure and highly encouraged for those using tournament and/or resort shuttles. Located below the Locker Room in the Cart Garage. The Golf Shop and Outside Services Staff will manage the bag storage area.
- **FITNESS CENTER** is available at Atlantis Paradise Island for guests of the Resort(s) near the Royal Towers on the lower level. Hours of operation are listed above and a Room Key Card is required.
- **CHIROPRACTOR/PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the tented structure near the Practice Tee. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **EMERGENCY MEDICAL** Medics will also be on-site for any immediate emergencies and will maintain the same hours of operation as the practice facilities.
- YARDAGE BOOKS will be issued to players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies <u>MUST</u> use the 2025 Committee Approved Book.
- CREDENTIALS If you have not received your Korn Ferry Tour 2025 credential please see Lisa Ferraro at Player Registration.

AGRONOMY

The Ocean Club at Atlantis Paradise Island is connected to New Providence Island in the Bahamas near Nassau. Designed by Tom Weiskopf nearly 25 years ago, this ocean-side golf course features larger-than-average greens with dense TifEagle bermudagrass surfaces. Fairways, tees, and approaches were originally planted with Paspalum and have been invaded by other grasses over time. The rough is consistent and healthy. Some bunkers show their age with encroachment from native sand and coral. New sand is added annually to maintain playability and consistency. High winds from the north during this season can cause sand to move from the beach onto the property.

Quick Facts:

- The target greenspeed will be 10 10.5'.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.350 0.375".
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.425 0.450".
- The primary rough will be maintained at 1.25" with no intermediate cut.
