

PASSPORT RENEWAL

In preparation for ZOZO Championship and upcoming international tournaments, please read the following regarding your passport requirements for visa processing. Please make sure your passport meets the following requirements:

- Has at least 5 blank VISA pages (this does not include amendment pages) please take into account any international upcoming travel that may take up visa pages.
- Expires AFTER May 1, 2025

If your US Passport does not meet these requirements, or if you would like to apply for a secondary US Passport, please contact Danyelle with Dash Passports and Visas as soon as possible (Danyelle@ DashPPV.com).

In addition, if you are planning to travel internationally in September/ October during visa processing (which would include participating in the Presidents Cup), and you are a US Citizen, you will need to apply for a secondary passport, as your passport will need to be collected for visa processing in September. Danyelle can also assist with applying for a secondary passport.

If your Non-US Passport does not meet the requirements, or you would like to check to see if a secondary passport is offered, please contact your consulate.

VISA INFORMATION

Once again, players and caddies participating in the ZOZO Championship will be required to obtain a Certificate of Eligibility (CoE) prior to applying for their entertainment Visa to enter Japan for the event. Player support, family, etc., are not required to apply for the CoE. In addition, there are currently no Covid restrictions for entering Japan.

Representatives will be on-site Monday - Wednesday during the Wyndham Championship and the FedEx St. Jude Championship to help players with the CoE applications. Exact times will be posted in the Player Advance Sheet. The following are requirements to process the CoE:

- Application for issuance of a CoE First page.
- One (1) Photograph taken on site.
- Passport Copy A clear/ color copy is needed for the CoE application. When submitting the visa application, the physical passport is needed.
- Caddie's Resume Caddies Only.
- Players and Caddies MUST be submitted at the same time in order to be processed.





Please note: processing time for the CoE may take several weeks, and we will not be able to accept any applications after Thursday, August 17, 2024. Any player considering playing in the ZOZO Championship, if eligible, is *strongly encouraged* to apply for the CoE to ensure appropriate documentation is available when applying for a visa and entering Japan. *There is no cost to apply for the CoE*.

The CoE is submitted in Japan and once returned, will be available to include with the player/caddie Visa application. Visa applications (along with passports) will be collected in September, and will be processed in the United States. Players and caddies not in the field for the tournament will receive instructions on how to submit for the Visa, individually.

Players or caddies who enter the United States on a B1/B2 Visa must apply for the Japanese Visa in their home country. We will supply those individuals with all documentation needed to submit the application. Please note, they will still require a CoE and can apply for that in person at the Wyndham Championship or FedEx St Jude Championship.

A complimentary charter will be scheduled from Las Vegas following the Shriners Children's Open to Tokyo and will return to the United States (city TBD) following the ZOZO Championship.
