## NEED TO KNOW

- **AVERAGE STROKE TIME (AST)** is being recorded each week. At the conclusion of a tournament, a player's stroke time (AST) is compared against the field average. For a given tournament, if a player has an average stroke time of 7.0 seconds or more above the field average, he has recorded an average stroke time (AST) infraction and will be notified via email on Monday or Tuesday following the tournament by the Competitions Department via email with additional details regarding the infraction. AST infractions are accumulated during the season before monetary fines are applied. Players can track their progress via the Player Links App. Instructional information to find their AST on the Links app can be found in the Bluesheet.
- **REGISTRATION** must be completed before practice or play. Player & Caddie Registration will be located inside the clubhouse in the Palace Bar. This room may be accessed by the exterior stairwell next to the permanent scoreboard on the north side of the clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above.

**NOTE:** At registration, players may be asked to provide a "walk up" song for the 17<sup>th</sup> hole.
- **TICKETS** for general admission will be available at registration.
- **CLUB STORAGE** will not be available this week.
- **LOCKER ROOM** is located in the SW corner of the clubhouse. However, usage of the locker room facilities will be limited. While you will be allowed access to bathroom and shower facilities, due to the fact there are no shoe cleaning facilities or attendant in the locker room, **players will NOT have access to a locker** nor will there will be a locker room fee collected at registration. **Note:** Crestview CC members will also have access to the locker room facilities throughout tournament week. Per tournament regulations, golf bags cannot be stored in the locker room overnight. In addition, due to member access to the locker room, it is highly recommended that golf bags not be left unattended in the locker room at any time during the day.
- **PRODUCT STORAGE/DISTRIBUTION AREA** will be utilized in lieu of the locker room. This area will be located in office space near the stairwell just inside the north entrance of the clubhouse. If you are expecting a package, please see someone from the player registration committee or tournament staff for access to this area.
- The **FAR END OF THE RANGE** is for the exclusive use of Crestview CC members and will not be available to Korn Ferry Tour players.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the club's main parking lot. Parking passes are not required, but players will need to show their Tour-issued credential.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be located in the "Garden Room" inside the Crestview CC clubhouse every day with the exception of Monday and Wednesday (see above chart for details). This room can be found just inside and to the right of the North clubhouse entrance. Player dining will only be open to players, one player spouse with a TOUR issued credential as well as their children. Please refer hours of operation above. **NOTE:** Tuesday through Sunday, the Crestview CC dining room and bar area will be available as an additional option from 11 a.m. – 8 p.m. Credit card only accepted for payment.

- **CADDIE PARKING** will be located in the grassy area adjacent to the Korn Ferry Tour truck in the nw corner of the club's parking lot. This area can be accessed through the club's main entrance. Caddies will only need to identify themselves as a Tour caddie to access the lot.
- **CADDIE DINING** is complimentary. Breakfast will be served at the north entrance to the cart barn (near permanent scoreboard - directly under registration area) and lunch will be served in the Scheels Event Center located between the 10<sup>th</sup> tee & the 18<sup>th</sup> green. Caddies are welcome to take their breakfast into the Event Center to eat and are always welcome to relax in this space unless there is a brief event awards ceremony taking place. This is a climate-controlled space the caddies are sharing with the volunteers.
- **YARDAGE BOOKS** will be issued to all players and caddies free of charge at registration. Players and caddies **MUST** use the 2022, 2023 or Committee Approved book.
- **SELECT PRO-AM** will take place on **Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup>**. This 18-hole pro-am will consist of approximately 13 teams and will begin with a 12 Noon shotgun on holes 1-11 only. The course will be available for practice rounds all day – working around the holes that are occupied by the pro-am.
- **COX BUSINESS PRO-AM** will take place on **Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup>**. It will be a **9 & 9 format** with starting times from approximately 6:50 a.m. to 8:56 a.m. and 12:20 p.m. to 2:26 pm. There will be approximately 52 teams. 9-hole practice rounds will be available prior to the Pro-Am only (practice rounds must not interfere with the Pro-Am pace of play). See below for practice facility restrictions during the Official Pro-Am.
- **PRACTICE ROUNDS** beginning on hole #10 must yield in all instances to players making the turn and must not delay practice rounds at any time. Abuse of the Practice Area Policy may result in disciplinary action.
- **PRIVATE HOUSING** will be provided on availability and on a first come first served basis. If interested, please contact Housing Chair – Megan Metcalf at [meganmetcalf08@yahoo.com](mailto:meganmetcalf08@yahoo.com)
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** will be in the clubhouse in the Board Room. This room can be found by going up the stairs that are just inside the north entrance to the clubhouse – near player dining.
- **WORKOUT FACILITIES** will be made available by Crestview CC at no charge. The fitness room is located inside the Crestview Sports Complex, which is next to the swimming pool in the sw corner of the parking lot. The hours will be Mon-Thurs 6 am- 8 pm, Fri 6 am – 6 pm & Sat-Sun 8 am – 4 pm.
- **OFF-SITE CHIROPRACTIC CARE** will be offered complimentary by Dr. Mike Stanley at Stanley Chiropractic (11444 E. Central Ave, Wichita, KS – O: 316/685-4965, C: 316/299-8914). - **OTHER CRESTVIEW AMENITIES** that will be available to players and their wives include use of the club's pool which will be open daily from 11 a.m. – 8 p.m. as well as the club's tennis and pickleball courts. Various other youth activities are available for a fee including tennis camps, science camps & Crestview Kids Cave. For more details, visit Player Links or contact Spencer Richmond, the Director of Youth Activities at Crestview. In addition, the players and their families are welcome to utilize the club's dining room & bar area. This area will be closed on Monday but will otherwise be open daily from 11 a.m. – 8 p.m. Credit cards only accepted for payment.
- A **PICKLEBALL SOCIAL** with Crestview members will be held from 5 p.m. – 7 p.m. at the Crestview Sports Complex (located next to the swimming pool in the sw corner of the parking lot). Crestview is providing light food and the Wichita Open is providing beverages.
- Access to a **WICHITA WIND SURGE BASEBALL GAME** will be available for players, their families and caddies on Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup> at Riverfront Stadium. The Wind Surge (AA affiliate of the Minnesota Twins) will be providing their Emprise Bank Pavilion which is located down the 1<sup>st</sup> base line and includes food and soft drinks/water throughout the game. There is also a cash bar available in the pavilion. 1<sup>st</sup> pitch will be at 7:05 p.m. Tickets are limited to the 1<sup>st</sup> 75 people and will be available at Player Registration.

### **Prior to Monday, June 10<sup>th</sup>**

## AGRONOMY

The turf health and playing surfaces at Crestview Country Club are in great shape for tournament play. The A-series greens are conditioned to provide smooth surfaces. Two small bentgrass approaches have been resodded due to winter kill but should be grown in by the event date. The zoysia grass fairways and tees are mostly in good condition with a few lingering weak areas in the drainage swales and drain basins from excessive wetness and frozen conditions during the winter. These areas should be much improved as the weather gets warmer and the days longer. Many of the bunkers have been renovated over the past few years for improved drainage and consistency. The intermediate cut around the fairways and greens has been eliminated.

### Quick Facts:

- The target speed will be 11.5'
- The tees, fairways and approaches will be mowed at 0.500”.
- The primary rough will initially be maintained at 2.50 inches and allowed to grow throughout tournament week. There is no intermediate rough.
