NEED TO KNOW

- **REGISTRATION** Must be completed before practice or play. Player Registration will be located in the Event Center (player dining) and Caddie Registration will be located in the clubhouse. Hours of operation are listed above. Yardage books will be available to both players and caddies at Registration.
- **PHYSICAL THERAPY** is located in the Cawley Center adjacent to the practice range tee. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **THE OKLAHOMA HIGH SCHOOL PRO-AM presented by COMPLIANCE SOLUTIONS, INC.** will take place on Monday, June 19th at Jimmie Austin GC and will be a 9:00 a.m. shotgun with 18 teams. If you are interested in playing please reach out to Shane Suber (706) 410-0149. Practice rounds will be available off #1 and #10 following the pro-am at 2:00 p.m.

- **OFFICIAL PRO-AM** will take place on Wednesday, June 21st as a 9 & 9 shamble (select drive) format with starting times off #1 from 9:00 a.m. – 1:10 p.m. with approximately 25 teams. Course available for practice rounds prior to the pro-am off #1 until 8:45 a.m. and off #10 until 7:30 a.m. (per Tournament Regulations). Practice on the course will be allowed after the pro-am for 9 holes only off #1 from 1:30 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.
- **PLAYER TICKET REQUESTS** should be made directly to Player Services located in Player Dining.
- **FITNESS FACILITY ACCESS** is not available.
- **PLAYER DINING** will be located in the “Event Center” adjacent to the clubhouse. Player dining will be open only to players and one spouse/significant other with a TOUR issued credential. Hours of operation are listed above.
- **PLAYER PARKING** will be located in the clubhouse parking lot. A parking pass and TOUR credential are required for access.

The Jimmie Austin Golf Club will host the inaugural Compliance Solutions Championship. This Perry Maxwell original was renovated by Architect, Bob Cupp followed by renovations by Tripp Davis & Associates. The putting surfaces are A-1/A-4 creeping bentgrass mixed with some *Poa annua* and are maintained to a high standard of care. The rest of the course boasts warm-season grasses. The zoysiagrass tees and mixed bermudagrass fairways fared well coming out of winter dormancy and are expected to be in good early-summer condition. The Zeon zoysiagrass approaches and green surrounds, however, were negatively affected by cold winter weather. Weak collars and surrounds directly adjacent to the putting surfaces were sodded in the middle of May. Given the slow-growing nature of zoysiagrass, these areas are expected to be rooted but with visual sod seams evident.

Quick Facts:

- The greenspeed will be in the range of 11.5 - 12.0'.
- The tees and approaches will be mowed at 0.225".
- The fairways will be mowed at 0.350".

- There will be no intermediate rough, and the primary rough will be maintained between 2.00 - 2.50”.
