DETERMINATION OF TIME ALLOTTED FOR PLAY FOR THE ROUND

The Rules Committee will determine the amount of time that an 'average group' of players is expected to play a round in groups of three or four. Each hole to be played will be assigned an amount of time using the below framework as a guiding principle:

	Groups of Two Players	Groups of Three Players	Groups of Four Players
Par 3 Holes	10 Minutes	11 Minutes	12 Minutes
Par 4 Holes	12 Minutes	14 Minutes	16 Minutes
Par 5 Holes	15 Minutes	18 Minutes	20 Minutes

Additional, or less time, may be allotted to a given hole based on the following four factors:

- 1) Length of the hole
- 2) Difficulty of the hole
- 3) Length and topography of walk between the green and tee/shuttle time
- 4) Historical data of the average time taken to play the hole

Once the 'Time Chart' has been finalized (typically no later than Wednesday of tournament week), it will be displayed on the pla and caddie notice boards, including the virtual locker room and available at the starting tees.

In the event of adverse or unexpected weather, the Rules Committee will make the necessary adjustments in the field.

NOTABLE CHANGES TO THE 2025 KORN FERRY TOUR PACE OF PLAY POLICY

- 1) Out of Position verbiage amended to recognize if a group is on a par-3 hole and the group in front is still on the teeing ground of the next hole, they are in good position. In addition, for a group to be in position on a par-4 hole, ALL players must have made a stroke from the teeing area, before the hole is open and clear of play.
- 2) Further clarification and context provided to the cadence of timing by Referees (i.e. when the clock starts for a given shot/what actions are permitted before the clock starts).
- 3) Timings, Bad Times and Excessive Shot Times accrued at Major Championships DO NOT count towards a player's cumulative season total.
- 4) The fine for 2 Bad Times remain at \$1,000.
- 5) The fine for 2 Excessive Shot Times has been reduced from \$1,000 to \$500.
- 6) The fine for 10 Average Shot Time violations will remain at \$2,000 (to align with the fine for 10 Timings).
- 7) Adjustment to the Average Shot Time logic when players play more than 9 holes in a group of 2 when groups of 3 have been scheduled.
- 8) Expansion of the fine structure for players that have a tournament Average Shot Time that is deemed to be excessive. Any player with a tournament average of 12 seconds above TOUR average will be receive an Excessive Average Shot Time Violation.
- 9) Expanded verbiage that allows the Rules Committee the discretion to sanction players that have an Average Shot Time that is consistently above TOUR average.
