Ferry Information: Ferry between the Hamilton Princess and Port Royal Golf Course is available for all individuals tested and considered inside the bubble.

Dates of Operation: Monday, October 26 - Sunday, November 1. Hours of Operation: 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (Monday & Tuesday) 5:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (Wednesday - Sunday)

The ferry will run every 30 minutes on the hour and half hour. Caddies will take the ferry from the hotel docks and then board a bus for a short ride to the course.
