Extended Forecast – Mostly sunny to partly cloudy skies are expected tomorrow and Saturday as high pressure remains over the area. A slight chance of showers will develop by Sunday afternoon into the evening with greater chances evolving after dark into Monday morning. Overnight lows will be in the mid-50s to lower 60s with daytime highs in the 80s. Light and variable winds each morning will trend around 5-10 mph except for Sunday into early next week when afternoon gusts between 15-20 mph will be possible.
