Extended forecast – Conditions will gradually become more conducive for shower development as the week progress. Initially, shower coverage/intensity will be limited Saturday/Sunday with only brief spurts of rain possible. By Monday, a front will reach the Bahamas and then linger over the islands through Wednesday. This period will feature higher rain chances as showers during this period could become more organized and persistent. Winds speeds likely fluctuate on a day-to-day basis with Monday experiencing the strongest wind speeds of the week.
