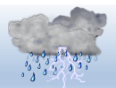

This Afternoon – High temperatures reach near 90F with heat indices between 95-100F between 3-5pm. If the lake breeze from Lake Michigan can advance near The Glen Club, that could provide the lifting mechanism for updrafts to tap into the increased heat/humidity/instability and lead to shower/t-storm development after around 2-3pm. Higher potential for scattered thunderstorms exists later tonight, especially after sunset. **Rainfall before 12am Monday: <0.10"**; **Rainfall between 12-10am Monday: 0.25-0.50" on average, though locally higher amounts to 1-2" are possible in heavier downpours.**

Monday – Scattered thunderstorms potentially linger into the late morning hours, with partly cloudy skies anticipated through much of the afternoon. High temperatures reach near 90F with heat indices approaching 100F (warmest between 1-4pm). An isolated shower/thunderstorm can't be ruled out during the late afternoon/early evening. **Rainfall between 12-10am Monday: 0.25-0.50" on average, though locally higher amounts to 1-2" are possible in heavier downpours | Sunrise: 5:39am / Sunset: 8:17pm**
