Today & Tomorrow – Dry conditions to continue through tonight with increasing/thicker cloud cover. Low pressure will approach the California coast on Tuesday with showers becoming increasingly likely Tuesday afternoon/night. Rumbles of thunder are possible Tuesday night. The other concern is a period of strong winds with gusts potentially exceeding 40 mph Tuesday night. Forecast rainfall Tuesday/Tuesday night: 0.25-0.50". **Sunrise: 7:01am / Sunset: 5:42pm**

Extended forecast – Pockets of showers likely linger over the Monterey Peninsula through Wednesday. The strongest activity could produce a couple strikes of lightning. A period of dry/quiet weather should return Thursday/Friday. The next potential period of unsettled weather may arrive this weekend, however there has been a slowing trend from recent guidance. Depending on how this system evolves, a period of rain and gusty winds could occur, mainly on Sunday. Beyond the rain/wind potential, temperatures will likely remain cool with daytime highs in the upper 50s to near 60F and overnight lows in the 40s to near 50F
