Rest of Today – Sunny, breezy and cool conditions will continue for the rest of the afternoon with highs only reaching the low 60s. Otherwise, it will be a cold night with temperatures falling back into the upper 40s this evening and into the upper 30s by daybreak Tuesday. The wind chill will make it feel much colder in the low 30s at times overnight as well. The breeze is forecast to average around 10 mph overnight helping to keep frost to a minimum.

Extended forecast – After the cold start Tuesday morning, temperatures will moderate into the low to mid 60s during the afternoon. The breeze is expected to weaken and make conditions feel more comfortable. Temperatures will continue to moderate the rest of the week with highs returning to the 80s Thursday into the weekend. Another front is expected to stall across Central Florida with upper-level energy moving across the region. This will likely increase the instability allowing for the chance of scattered showers and thunderstorms Friday afternoon into Saturday.
