Today – Mostly cloudy with a few showers expected to develop in the vicinity of TPC Louisiana this morning. By late morning and into the afternoon anticipate that a scattered coverage of slow-moving areas of rain and thunderstorms will materialize before diminishing in coverage late this afternoon and into the evening. South-southeasterly winds will become a bit breezy this afternoon, sustained at 10-15 mph along with occasional higher gusts. The temperature will reach a high in the low 80s.

Forecast rainfall: 0.10" – 0.25", with locally higher totals near 1" in slow-moving thunderstorms.

Extended forecast – A scattered late afternoon thunderstorm threat will now continue Friday before more stable conditions arrive this weekend. Anticipate just a few showers or an isolated thunderstorm each afternoon this weekend as a ridge of high pressure limits activity. Southeasterly winds will become slightly breezy after 10-11am Friday, sustained at 10-15 mph. Temperatures will start out in the upper 60s to low 70s each morning before climbing into the mid 80s.
