Today – Remnants of overnight thunderstorms may produce a light shower or two this morning. Otherwise, scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected to increase in coverage midday into the afternoon as upper-level energy approaches from the west. Storms will likely produce heavy rainfall and possibly some gusty wind, but the severe threat will be low today. Showers and storms will move to the east this evening with improving conditions.

Extended forecast– Thunderstorm chances are forecast to decrease Friday as North Texas will be in-between systems with only a slight chance for a shower or thunderstorm during the afternoon. The chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms increases this weekend once again as upper-level energy stalls over Texas through early next week. Showers and storms can occur at any time, but the higher likelihood will be during the afternoon and evening hours.
