


**Today** – Skies will become mostly cloudy for a portion of the morning, otherwise anticipate partly cloudy skies for most of the day. Isolated showers and weak thunderstorms may pop up in the afternoon out ahead of a cold front dropping down into North Texas overnight. Southerly winds will become breezy, sustained at 12-16 mph and gusting between 20-25 mph. The temperature will reach a high around 96°F with a heat index topping out near 101°F.
