Today – Currently monitoring showers and thunderstorms over southern Pennsylvania, with potential impacts at Caves Valley between 2-5pm. The threat for showers/T-storms eventually comes to an end by this evening with clearing skies overnight. Some patchy areas of low overcast or fog will be possible by daybreak. Forecast rainfall: 0.10-0.25" with localized amounts up to 0.50" in a T-storm. **Sunrise: 6:18am / Sunset: 8:04pm**

Extended forecast – The biggest change was to include a slight (20%) chance for an afternoon shower/T-storm to the Friday forecast. For this weekend, the forecast will continue to maintain the very slight (15%) shower/T-storm threat, although dry conditions likely prevail during this period. Temperatures each day should reach the upper 80s to near 90 degrees. Generally light winds are expected through the weekend, although a few gusts closer to 15 mph could occur on Friday and Sunday.
