Extended forecast – A cold front will be moving through the region bringing a good chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms Monday. A few storms could be strong with gusty wind and heavy rainfall. Otherwise, high pressure will build over the region providing slightly cooler and less humid conditions through Wednesday before the heat and humidity returns later in the week. Temperatures will likely return to the low 90s Thursday into the weekend with partly cloudy skies. The chances for scattered showers and thunderstorms will return Friday into the weekend as a weak front approaches.
