

Extended forecast – High pressure will provide a nice day Saturday with mostly sunny skies and highs around 74F/23C. The high will shift east allowing clouds to increase Sunday as a weak area of low-pressure moves northeast across Western New York. This may produce a few showers across the area during the late afternoon into the early evening hours. This system will quickly move away Sunday night before a cold front brings a better chance for showers Monday into Tuesday.
