Rest of Today – High and mid-level clouds will continue to stream over the state making for partly sunny to mostly cloudy skies at times. Temperatures are already in the mid 80s and should top out around 90F/32C. A thunderstorm complex is expected to move along the NC/VA during the late afternoon. This activity will stay well north of the Charlotte area with no impact to the championship. Another thunderstorm complex will develop overnight and weaken as it approaches the area towards daybreak.

Extended forecast – A thunderstorm complex ahead of a cold front will be weakening as it approaches the Charlotte area early tomorrow morning. There may be a few showers or an isolated thunderstorm between 6am-9am if it can hold together. Rainfall amounts will be light and will likely average 0.05" or less. Otherwise, drier air will overspread the area during the afternoon making for less humid conditions with partly cloudy skies. The front will be south of the region Sunday with slightly cooler temperatures and highs in the mid-80s.
