Today – A weak front will stall near San Antonio this afternoon. This boundary will be monitored for any shower/T-storm development but it appears unlikely anything will form. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies can be expected with temperatures reaching the upper 80s. Clouds return to the area tonight with an uptick in southeast winds. Some areas of drizzle will be possible towards daybreak. **Sunrise: 7:22am / Sunset: 7:52pm**

Extended forecast – Morning clouds with pockets of drizzle or light showers are possible Thursday morning with dry conditions and decreasing clouds favored the rest of the day. The threat for showers/T-storms will begin to increase on Friday as a cold front approaches the area. Currently, the most likely period for showers/T-storms would be Friday afternoon through Saturday morning. Once this front clears, drier and cooler conditions are expected the rest of the weekend. The magnitude of the winds Saturday/Sunday remain in flux with the current forecast leaning towards the high end of potential.
