Today – Dry conditions are forecast with hazy sunshine giving way to a mix of sun and clouds this evening. Canadian wildfire smoke is leading to an AQI category of ‘Unhealthy’ this morning. Anticipate that the air quality will slowly improve into the ‘Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups Category’ (AQI 101-150) this afternoon as south-southeasterly winds of 5-12 mph push the smoke plume back northward. High temperature: 85°F.

Extended forecast – A weak disturbance may allow for an isolated coverage of showers and perhaps a brief thunderstorm to develop after 10am Saturday. Sunday will start off dry with isolated pop-up thunderstorms becoming possible after 1pm. Scattered thunderstorms are anticipated after 7-8pm Sunday evening with chances lingering into early Monday morning. Southerly winds of 5-10 mph are forecast each morning this weekend, with wind speeds increasing to 8-15 mph each afternoon. Temperatures will climb into the upper 80s to low 90s as humidity levels also increase – allowing for a peak heat index in the mid-90s on Saturday and near 100°F on Sunday.
