**Extended forecast** – Wednesday, partly cloudy, dry, and windy. South-southwest winds gust to 30-35 mph, peaking from 1-7pm. Thursday, a cold front will bring a chance of scattered showers and a few thunderstorms, highest chance in the afternoon/evening. Winds will be breezy from the southwest, with gusts to 25-30 mph, peaking 12-7pm. Friday, expect mostly cloudy and slightly cooler conditions with largely dry weather. A chance of showers may return on Saturday as a system to the south tries to sneak further north towards our area. A low chance of an isolated shower/t-storm remains on Sunday afternoon, with higher chances still Sunday night into Monday. The weekend forecast remains a bit lower confidence and trends will be monitored.
