Extended forecast – High pressure will begin to build into the region on Tuesday. There may be just enough lingering moisture to kick off an isolated shower or thunderstorm. Otherwise, high pressure will provide partly cloudy skies and hot temperatures Wednesday through Saturday with highs around 90F. Cannot rule out an isolated shower or thunderstorm each day, but most locations will remain dry. A cold front is forecast move into North-Central Florida that may increase chances for showers and thunderstorms for the final round Sunday afternoon into Sunday night.
